Restrictions to movement of materials on Angel escalators 1-6

BACKGROUND:

Fatigue cracking has been found on Angel escalators 1-6. These assets now require restrictions on movement of materials.

This alert does not apply to ERU attending sites for emergencies.



ACTION:

All movement of materials on Lift and Escalator assets on Angel escalators 1-6 work requires an approved and valid Movement of Materials Application (MoMA).

Hand held items which do not exceed 1.8 metres in length or 25 kg in weight can continue to be conveyed on Angel escalators 1-6. The requirements of CAT1 Standard, No.1-092, Issue A2, Attachment 9 Section 4 (hand held items) must be clearly communicated and complied with by those who carry such materials and be suitably supervised.

The transportation of any materials greater than specified above should still comply with CAT1 Standard, No.1-092, Issue A2, Attachment 9 and will still require the submission of a MoMA, which will be subject to additional controls such as a plant limit of 50 kg standing by itself on an escalator step or 50 kg plant carried by greater than two people over two or more steps. Further controls could include supervision and on site audit as directed by the notified person. Plant items are not to exceed 50 kg at Angel escalators 1-6.

Failure to comply will result in immediate cancellation of the Application.
