Damaged Fibreglass Cable Covers

BACKGROUND:

An incident occurred recently at Golders Green Depot where an operative was injured as he stepped on the edge of a glass reinforced plastic (GRP) fibreglass cable cover and it broke. As the cover broke, a section flew up hitting him on his left shin causing grazing and swelling.

The injured party was treated by a first aider on site then returned to his duties.



ACTION:

- Please be aware that many of the GRP fibreglass cable covers are cracked and damaged, so extra care should be taken when working within the Golders Green Depot area.
- Any damaged or broken covers which are potentially hazardous, note their location and report via the IRF system as well as advising the depot manager.
