

BRITs Mastercard ticket competition

Transport for London terms and conditions

The Competition begins on 12:45pm 03/02/20 (“the Opening Date”) and ends on 12:45pm 06/02/20 (“the Closing Date”). Entries to the Competition must be submitted before the Closing Date.

In order to enter you must submit a comment and it must be your original work.

To submit a comment you must visit <https://instagram.com/transportforlondon> and submit a comment on the competition post. Any entry which is incomplete or submitted through an alternative method will be rejected.
