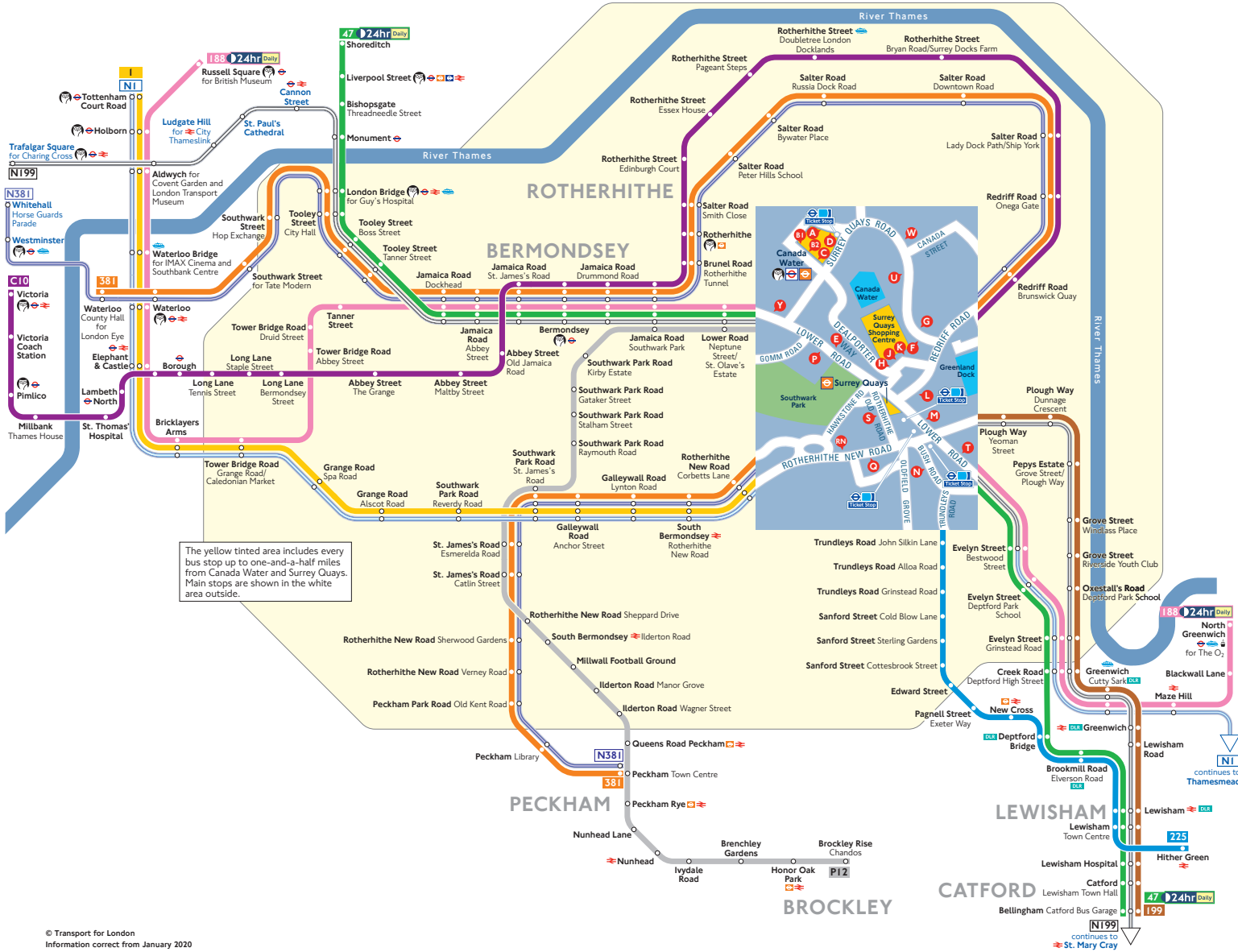


# Buses from Canada Water and Surrey Quays
