- Mondays to Saturdays, also Sunday shopping hours

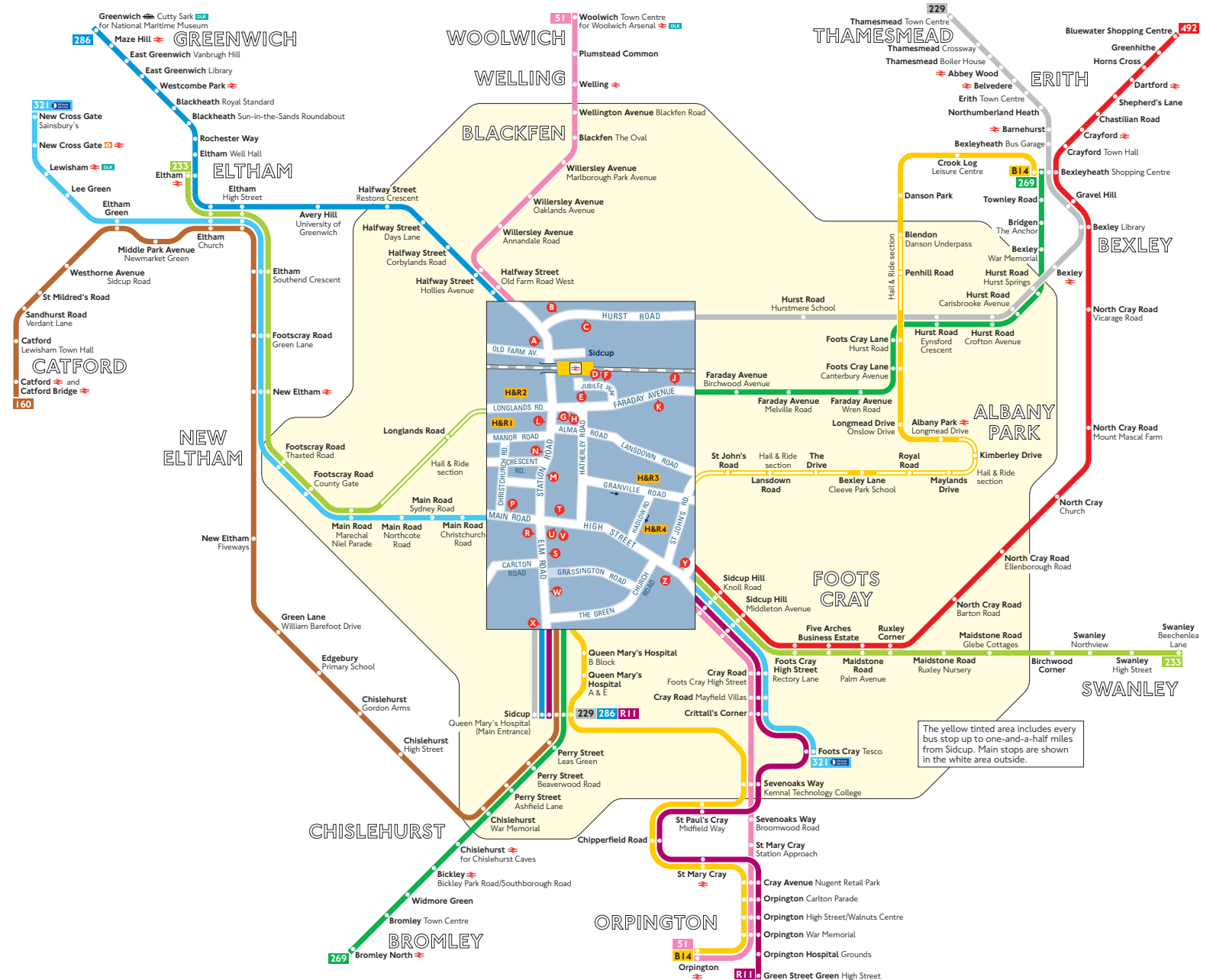
Red discs show the bus stop you need for your chosen bus service. The disc **A** appears on the top of the bus stop in the street (see map of town centre in centre of diagram).

**H&R** Routes 233 and B14 operate as hail and ride on the sections of roads marked **H&R** on the map. Buses stop at any safe point along the roads. Please indicate clearly to the driver when you wish to board or alight.
