5	Canning Town - Romford	<p>To provide better connections, buses will be rerouted to serve Queen's Hospital, Romford. Go-Ahead will now operate the route (previously Stagecoach).</p> <p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we are changing the frequency:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Sunday daytime buses will run every 7 – 8 minutes (previously every 6 -7 minutes). In the morning peak period (between 0656 and 0835) buses will run every 5 minutes towards Canning Town. In the afternoon peak period (between 1621 and 1720) buses will run every 5 minutes towards Romford.

29	Trafalgar Square – Wood Green	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we are changing the frequency:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Friday peak time buses will run every 5 minutes (previously every 4 minutes) with additional buses running during the busiest hour. Monday to Saturday daytime buses will run every 6 minutes (previously every 5 minutes) with additional buses running during the busiest hour. Sunday and each evening buses will run every 7-8 minutes (previously every 6 minutes).
75	Lewisham – Croydon	<p>To better match school finishing time, the afternoon trip from Forest Green school (towards Lewisham) will depart at 1445.</p>
205	Paddington - Bow	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we are changing the frequency:</p> <p>Monday to Saturday daytime buses will run every 8 minutes (previously every 7-8 minutes).</p>
269	Bexleyheath – Bromley North station	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we are changing the frequency:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Saturday daytime buses will run every 12 minutes (previously every 10 minutes).
289	Purley – Elmers End	<p>Buses will be rerouted directly along Purley Way and no longer serve Waddon Marsh tram stop or Croydon Colonnades.</p>
455	Purley – Wallington station	<p>Buses will be rerouted directly along Purley Way and no longer serve Waddon Marsh tram stop.</p>
488	Bromley-by-Bow – Dalston Junction station	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we are changing the frequency:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Sunday daytime buses will run every 15 minutes (previously every 12 minutes)
H14	Hatch End – Northwick Park hospital	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we are changing the frequency:</p> <p>Monday to Friday peak time buses will run every 7-8 minutes (previously every 8-9 minutes).</p>

N8	Oxford Circus - Hainault	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we are changing the frequency:</p> <p>Friday and Saturday nights buses will run every 10 minutes (previously every 7-8 minutes).</p>
N29	Trafalgar Square – Enfield	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we are changing the frequency:</p> <p>Every night buses will run every 8 minutes (previously on Friday and Saturday nights buses run every 3-4 minutes between Trafalgar Square and Wood Green and every 10 minutes between Wood Green and Enfield).</p>
N91	Trafalgar Square – Cockfosters station	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we are changing the frequency:</p> <p>Friday and Saturday nights buses will run every 30 minutes (previously every 15 minutes).</p>
N98	Holborn - Stanmore	<p>To better match how often buses run with demand for them, we are changing the frequency:</p> <p>Friday and Saturday nights buses will run every 15 minutes (previously every 10 minutes).</p>
