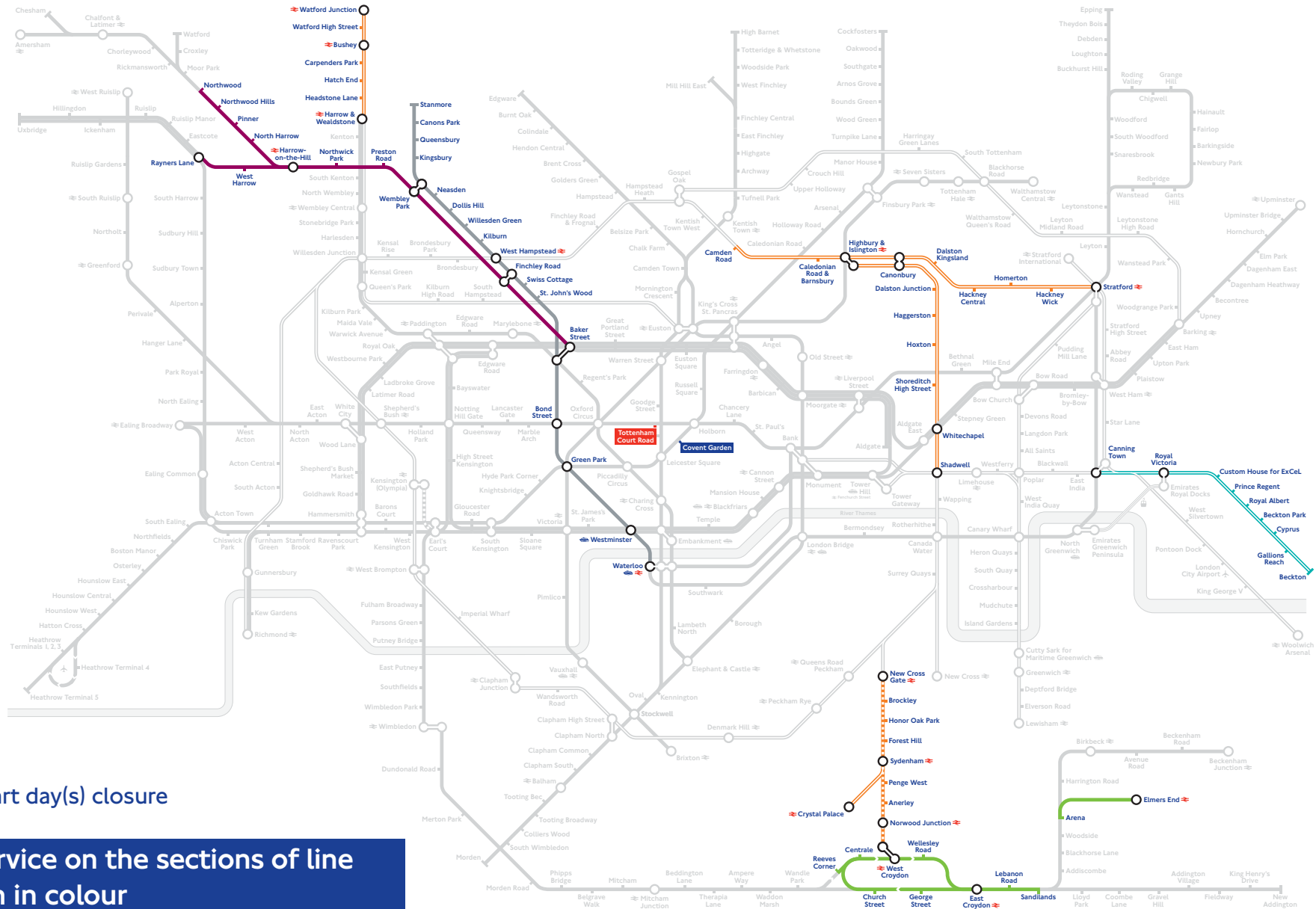


Network closures from 30 March until 6 April

Covent Garden station

Exit only until early November 2015. Also, on Saturdays and Sundays westbound trains will not stop. This is while we replace two lifts.

Tottenham Court Road station

Central line trains not stopping until early December 2015. This is while we carry out station improvement work.

Friday 3 to Sunday 5 April	Line closure Waterloo to Wembley Park This is while we replace the tunnel lining at Bond Street, replace points at Neasden and track at Finchley Road.  Bus replacement for local journeys: Service C: Stonebridge Park (for the Bakerloo line or London Overground services) – Wembley Park Service D: Baker Street – St. John's Wood – Swiss Cottage – Finchley Road – West Hampstead – Kilburn – Willesden Green – Dollis Hill – Neasden – Wembley Park
Monday 6 April	Line closure Waterloo to Stanmore  Bus replacement for local journeys: Service C: Stonebridge Park (for the Bakerloo line or London Overground services) – Wembley Park – Kingsbury – Queensbury – Canons Park – Stanmore Service D: Baker Street – St. John's Wood – Swiss Cottage – Finchley Road – West Hampstead (for National Rail services) – Kilburn – Willesden Green – Dollis Hill – Neasden – Wembley Park To find out more about our improvements for this line click here

Metropolitan line	
Friday 3 to Monday 6 April	Line closure Aldgate to Northwood/Uxbridge This is to allow for points work at Harrow and Neasden and track replacement work at Finchley Road.  Bus replacement for local journeys: Service A: Kenton (for the Bakerloo line or London Overground services) – Harrow-on-the-Hill – West Harrow – North Harrow – Rayners Lane (for the Piccadilly line) Service B: Northwood – Northwood Hills – Pinner – North Harrow – West Harrow – Harrow-on-the-Hill – Northwick Park – Kenton (for the Bakerloo line or London Overground services) – Preston Road – Wembley Park Service E: Watford Junction (for London Overground services, except Sunday) – Watford – Croxley – Rickmansworth – Ruislip (buses stopping northbound only, for the Piccadilly line) – West Ruislip (for the Central line or National Rail services) To find out more about our improvements for this line click here

Line closure Highbury & Islington to Shadwell

This is to enable Crossrail work at Whitechapel and TfL work at Highbury Corner.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Kingsland use local buses via all reasonable routes.

On Friday and Saturday use London Overground trains between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Kingsland. On Sunday replacement buses, which will run as follows:

Service S: Highbury & Islington – Canonbury – Dalston Junction

Service Q: Highbury & Islington – Dalston Junction

Between Dalston Junction and Shadwell on Friday to Sunday rail replacement buses will run as follows:

Service W: Dalston Kingsland – Dalston Junction – Haggerston – Hoxton – Shoreditch High Street – Whitechapel – Shadwell

Use London Underground services via all reasonable routes (for entrance/exit at Canada Water and Stratford stations only).

Line closure Sydenham to Crystal Palace

This is to enable Network Rail track work and TfL station work at Crystal Palace.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

On Friday and Saturday use Southern services.

On Sunday use local buses via all reasonable routes or replacement buses, which will run as follows:

(bus starts at Balham) – Crystal Palace – Anerley (also for Penge West) – Norwood Junction – Selhurst – West Croydon

Line closure New Cross Gate to West Croydon **Open from 0830**

This is to enable Network Rail track work.

Use local buses via all reasonable routes.

Line closure Queen's Park to Watford Junction

This is to enable Network Rail track work.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Watford Junction – Watford High Street – Bushey – Carpenders Park – Hatch End – Headstone Lane – Harrow & Wealdstone

Use Bakerloo line between Harrow & Wealdstone and Queen's Park.

Line closure Camden Road to Stratford

This is while we prepare the network for five car trains.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Service S: Camden Road – Holloway Road (Tube) (for Caledonian Road & Barnsbury) – Highbury & Islington – Canonbury – Dalston Junction (for Dalston Kingsland) – Hackney Central – Homerton – Hackney Wick – Stratford

Service Q: Camden Road – Highbury & Islington – Canonbury – Dalston Junction (for Dalston Kingsland) – Stratford

Line closure Reeves Corner to Sandilands

Owing to Croydon town centre improvement works and track renewal at Addiscombe Road and Tamworth Road.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Sandilands – East Croydon – Reeves Corner

- Trams from Beckenham Junction, Elmers End and New Addington will terminate at Sandilands.
- Trams from Wimbledon will terminate at Reeves Corner.
- Line 4 will not run.
- Bus 410 links East Croydon and Reeves Corner but due to extensive road works, through passengers may find it quicker to walk. A leaflet is available showing the walking route.

Line closure Reeves Corner to East Croydon

- Trams from Beckenham Junction, Elmers End and New Addington will terminate at East Croydon.
- Trams from Wimbledon will terminate at Reeves Corner.
- Line 4 will not run.

Line closure Canning Town to Beckton

This is to enable Crossrail work at Custom House.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Service A: Canning Town – Prince Regent – Royal Albert – Beckton Park – Cyprus – Gallions Reach – Beckton

This bus service will not stop at Royal Victoria please use bus service E.

The bus service will run every 7-10 minutes 0530-0130 on Saturday and 0630-0030 on Sunday.

Service E: Canning Town – ExCeL via Emirates Royal Docks

The bus service will run every 5-10 minutes 0530-0030 on Saturday and 0730-0000 on Sunday.

Allow extra time to complete your journey.

You must have a valid ticket before using replacement bus services.
