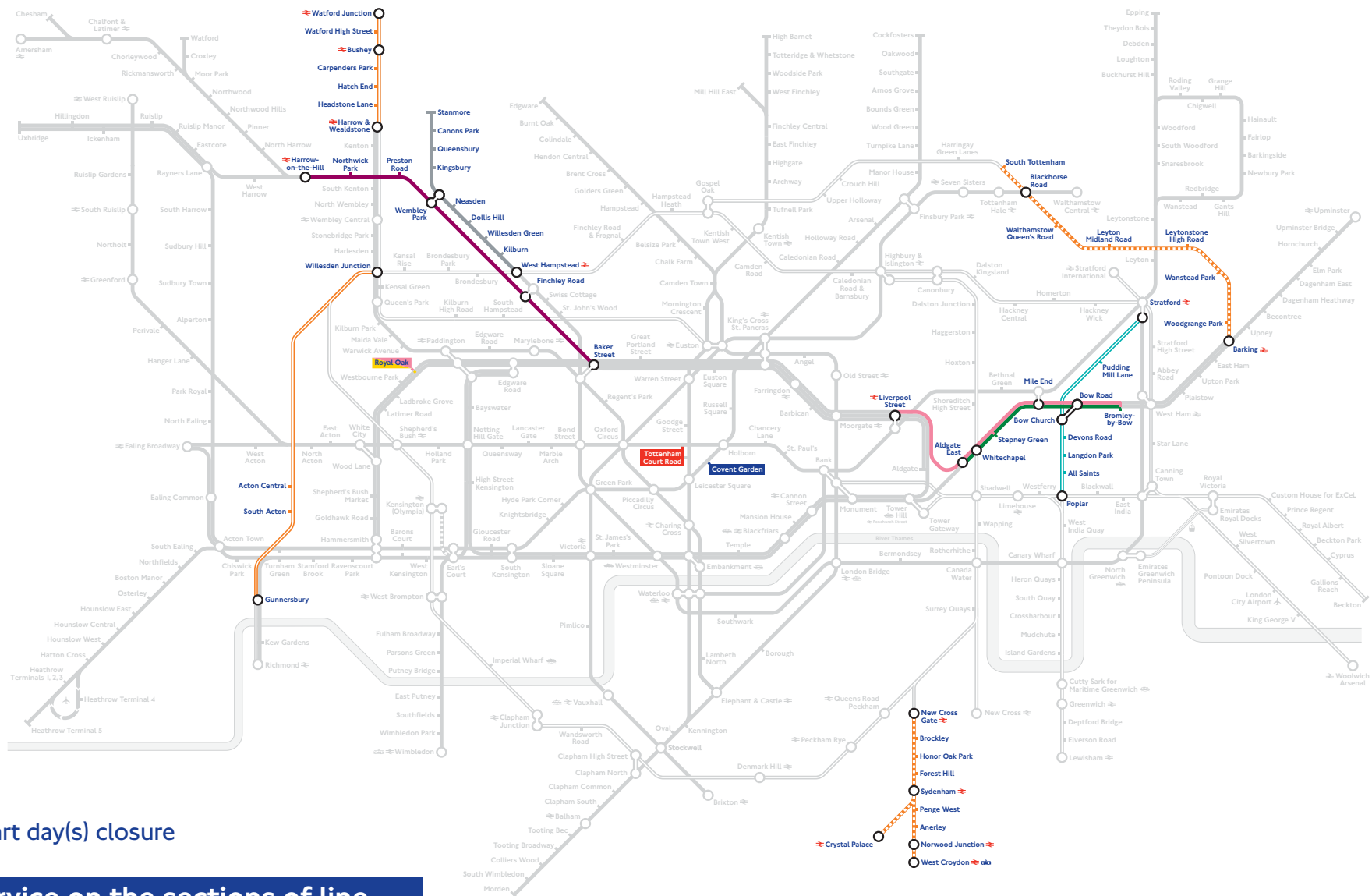


## Network closures weekend of 9/10 May

## Covent Garden station

Exit only until early November 2015. Also, on Saturdays and Sundays westbound trains will not stop. This is while we replace two lifts.

## Tottenham Court Road station

Central line trains not stopping until early December 2015. This is while we carry out station improvement work.

## Royal Oak station

Closed until mid-May. This is while we carry out station improvement work.

### Line closure Stratford to Poplar

This is to allow for station and track work.

#### Bus replacement for local journeys:

Stratford – Pudding Mill Lane – Bow Church – Devons Road – Langdon Park – All Saints – Blackwall – Canary Wharf

This bus will run every 10 minutes 0530-0130 on Saturday and 0630-0030 on Sunday.

### Line closure New Cross Gate to West Croydon Open from 0900

This is to enable Network Rail track work.

#### Bus replacement for local journeys:

New Cross Gate – Brockley – Honor Oak Park – Forest Hill – Sydenham – Crystal Palace – Anerley (also for Penge West) – Norwood Junction – Selhurst – West Croydon

### Line closure Sydenham to Crystal Palace Open from 0830

This is to enable Network Rail track work.

#### Bus replacement for local journeys:

New Cross Gate – Brockley – Honor Oak Pak – Forest Hill – Sydenham – Crystal Palace – Anerley (also for Penge West) – Norwood Junction – Selhurst – West Croydon

### Line closure South Tottenham to Barking Open from 1200

This is to enable Network Rail bridge work.

#### Bus replacement for local journeys:

South Tottenham – Blackhorse Road – Walthamstow Queen's Road – Walthamstow Central (Tube) – Leyton Midland Road – Leytonstone High Road – Wanstead Park – Woodgrange Park – Barking

### Line closure Queen's Park to Watford Junction

This is to enable Network Rail track work.

#### Bus replacement for local journeys:

Harrow & Wealdstone – Headstone Lane – Hatch End – Carpenders Park – Bushey – Watford High Street – Watford Junction

Use Bakerloo line between Harrow & Wealdstone and Queen's Park

### Line closure Willesden Junction to Richmond

This to enable Network Rail track work.

#### Bus replacement for local journeys:

Willesden Junction – Acton Central – South Acton – Gunnersbury

Use District line between Richmond and Gunnersbury

Allow extra time to complete your journey.

You must have a valid ticket before using replacement bus services.
