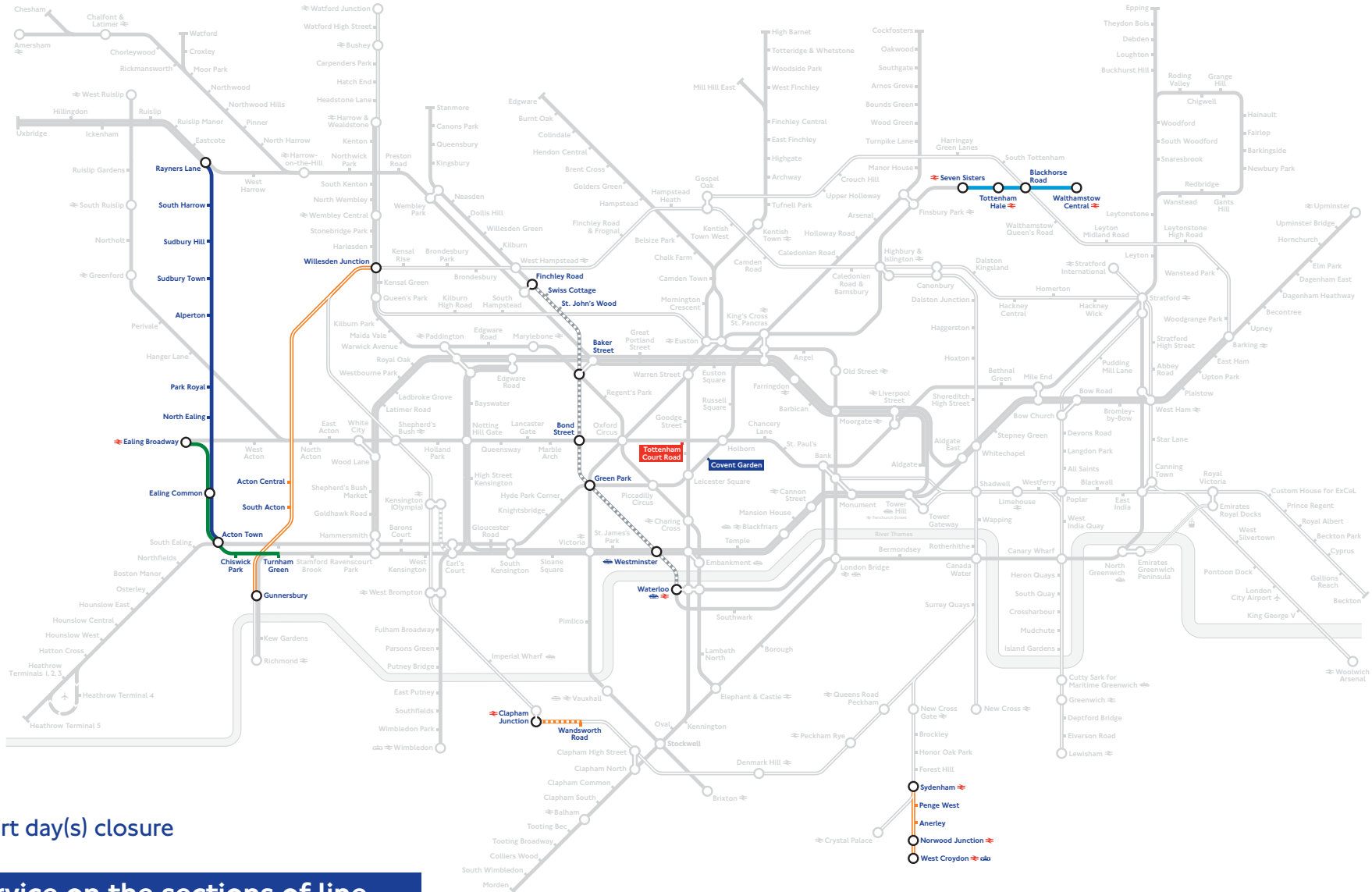


Network closures weekend of 16/17 May

Line closure Clapham Junction to Wandsworth Road **Open from 1015**

This is to enable Network Rail track work.

Trains will run along an alternative route to/from Battersea Park. Use local buses via all reasonable routes between Clapham Junction and Battersea Park/Surrey Quays or Southern services between Battersea Park and Clapham Junction

Line closure Sydenham to West Croydon

This is to enable Network Rail track work.

 **Bus replacement for local journeys:**

Crystal Palace – Anerley (also for Penge West) – Norwood Junction – Selhurst – West Croydon

Line closure Willesden Junction to Richmond

This to enable Network Rail track work.

 **Bus replacement for local journeys:**

Willesden Junction – Acton Central – South Acton – Gunnersbury

Use District line between Richmond and Gunnersbury

Allow extra time to complete your journey.

You must have a valid ticket before using replacement bus services.
