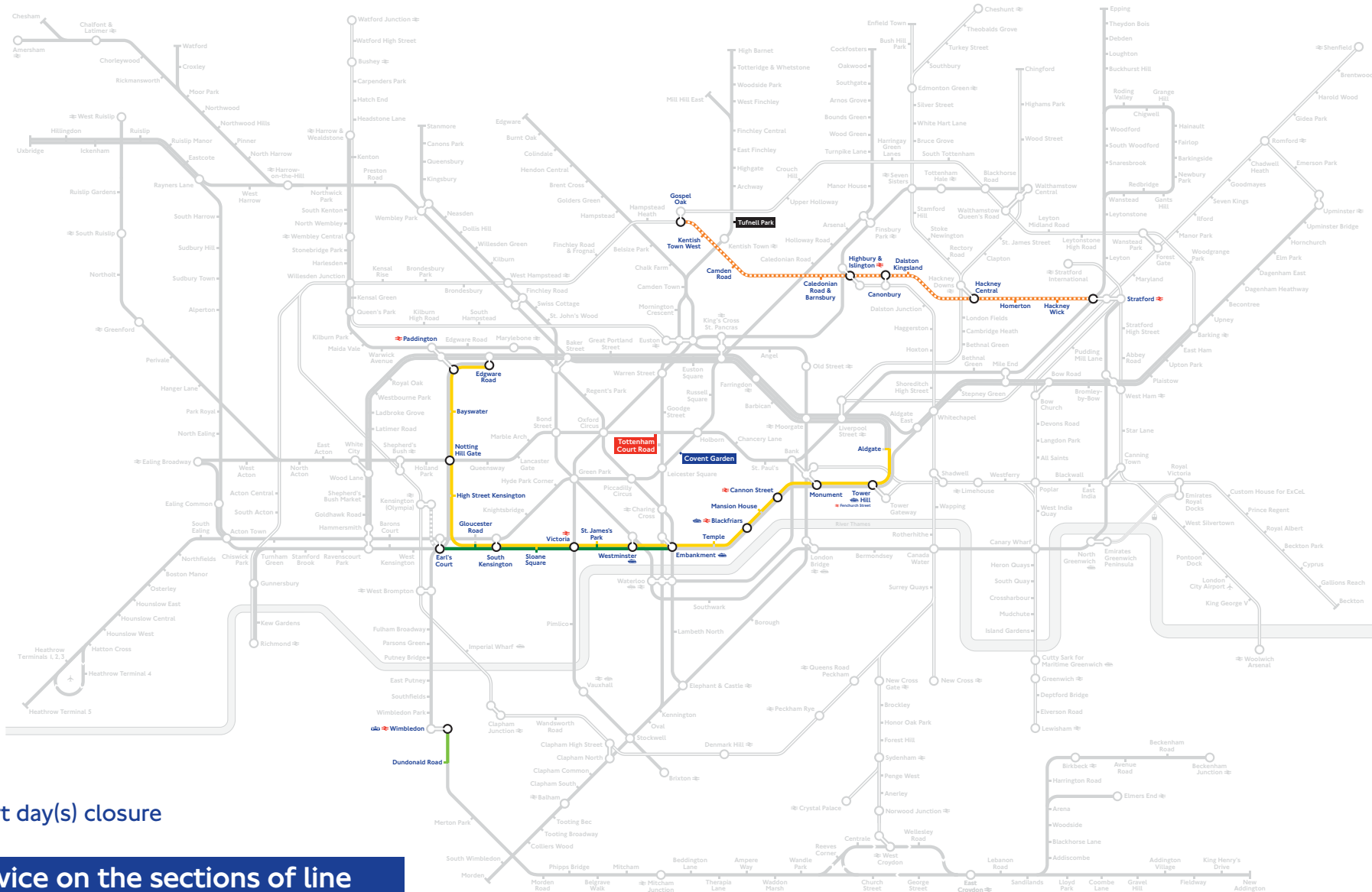


## Network closures weekend of 18/19 July

## Covent Garden station

Exit only until early November 2015. Also, on Saturdays and Sundays westbound trains will not stop. This is while we replace two lifts.

## Tottenham Court Road station

Central line trains not stopping until early December 2015. This is while we carry out station improvement work.

## Tufnell Park station

Station closed until mid-March 2016. This is while we replace both lifts.

This is to allow for Network Rail track work.

##### Bus replacement for local journeys:

Hampstead Heath – Gospel Oak (bus stops in Agincourt Road/Southampton Road) –  
Kentish Town West – Camden Road – Holloway Road (for Caledonian Road & Barnsbury) –  
Highbury & Islington – Canonbury – Dalston Junction (for Dalston Kingsland) –  
Hackney Central – Homerton – Hackney Wick – Stratford

A connecting westbound only bus service will also run at 2335 and 0010, only if required, at Hampstead Heath and set down only, as follows:

Hampstead Heath – Finchley Road Tube station (for Finchley Road & Frognal) –  
West Hampstead – Brondesbury – Brondesbury Park – Kensal Rise – Willesden Junction –  
Acton Central – South Acton – Gunnersbury – Kew Gardens (Victoria Gate) – Richmond

### Line closure Wimbledon to Dundonald Road

This is while we construct an additional platform and carry out enhancement work at Wimbledon station.

Trams will start and terminate at Dundonald Road which is around a 10 minute walk to Wimbledon station.

The walking route will be clearly signposted throughout the closure. Please allow extra time to complete your journey. You may find it easier to use an alternative route.

Local buses connect Wimbledon with London Trams at the following stops:

Merton Park – Wimbledon: 163 and 164

Morden Road – Wimbledon: 93

Phipps Bridge – Wimbledon: 200

Valid tram tickets will be accepted on these buses.

Allow extra time to complete your journey.

You must have a valid ticket before using replacement bus services.
