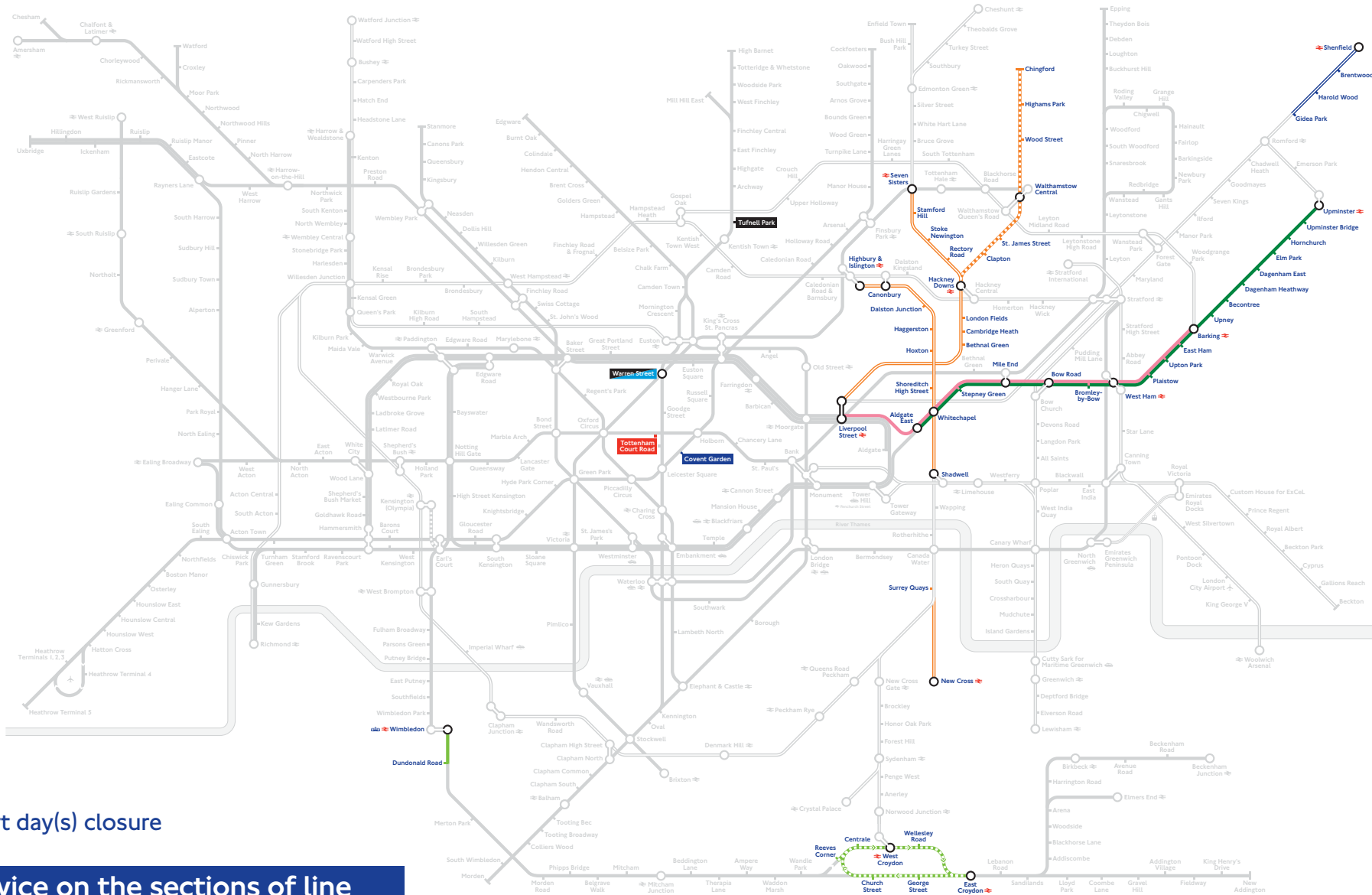


## Network closures weekend of 19/20 September



**KEY**

## Covent Garden station

Exit only until early November 2015. Also, on Saturdays and Sundays westbound trains will not stop. This is while we replace two lifts.

## Tottenham Court Road station

Central line trains not stopping until early December 2015. This is while we carry out station improvement work.

## Tufnell Park station

Station closed until mid-March 2016. This is while we replace both lifts.

## Warren Street station

Exit and interchange only between 0730 and 1000 Monday to Friday until late October. This is while we carry out maintenance on two escalators one at a time.

#### Line closure Aldgate East to Upminster

This is to allow for Crossrail work at Whitechapel, track and drainage replacement work at Mile End and Hornchurch and station improvement work at Stepney Green.

##### Bus replacement for local journeys:

**Service A:** Tower Hill – Aldgate/Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road (for DLR services) – Stratford (for other TfL and National Rail services) – Upton Park – East Ham – Barking (for National Rail services)

**Service B:** Mile End – Bow Road (for DLR services) – Bromley-by-Bow – Canning Town (for the Jubilee line and DLR services) – Plaistow – Stratford (for other TfL and National Rail services)

**Service C:** Barking (for National Rail services) – Upney – Becontree – Dagenham Heathway – Dagenham East

**Service D:** Barking (for National Rail services) – Dagenham East – Elm Park – Hornchurch – Upminster Bridge – Upminster (for National Rail services)

#### Line closure Liverpool Street to Barking

This is to allow for Crossrail work at Whitechapel, replacing track and drainage at Mile End and station improvement work at Stepney Green.

##### Bus replacement for local journeys:

**Service A:** Tower Hill – Aldgate/Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road (for DLR services) – Stratford (for other TfL and National Rail services) – Upton Park – East Ham – Barking (for National Rail services)

**Service B:** Mile End – Bow Road (for DLR services) – Bromley-by-Bow – Canning Town (for the Jubilee line and DLR services) – Plaistow – Stratford (for other TfL and National Rail services)

### Line closure **Gidea Park to Shenfield**

This is to allow Network Rail infrastructure work.

 **Bus replacement for local journeys:**

**Service B:** Gidea Park – Harrold Wood – Brentwood – Shenfield

Use Abellio Greater Anglia services between Gidea Park and Shenfield. This service will call at Harold Wood and Brentwood eastbound only.

### Line closure **Hackney Down to Chingford** **Open until 2230**

This to allow Network Rail track work.

Alternative travel arrangement: Use London Underground via all reasonable routes – these tickets will only be accepted for entrance/exit at Liverpool Street, Tottenham Hale and Walthamstow Central stations.

 **Bus replacement for local journeys:**

**Service L3:** Hackney Downs – Clapton – St. James Street – Walthamstow Central – Wood Street – Highams Park – Chingford (some services are extended to serve stations to/from Liverpool Street).

### Line closure **Liverpool Street to Seven Sisters/Walthamstow Central**

This is to allow Network Rail track work.

Alternative travel arrangement:

Use Abellio Greater Anglia services between Liverpool Street and Cheshunt (via Tottenham Hale)

Use local buses via all reasonable routes.

Use London Underground via all reasonable routes – these tickets will only be accepted for entrance/exit at Liverpool Street, Tottenham Hale, Seven Sisters and Walthamstow Central stations.

On Sunday 20 September 2015 between 1500 and 1645 southbound trains will not call at Silver Street, White Hart Lane or Bruce Grove (northbound trains are unaffected).

### Line closure **Highbury & Islington to Shadwell**

This is to allow Crossrail at Whitechapel and Network Rail works at Highbury Corner.

 **Bus replacement for local journeys:**

**Service W:** Dalston Kingsland – Dalston Junction – Haggerston – Hoxton – Shoreditch High Street – Whitechapel – Shadwell

Use London Underground services via all reasonable routes (for entrance/exit at Canada Water and Stratford stations only).

Use London Overground trains between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Kingsland or local buses via all reasonable routes.

### Line closure **Surrey Quays to New Cross**

This is to allow Crossrail at Whitechapel and Network Rail works at Highbury Corner.

Use local buses via all reasonable routes.

### Line closure Wimbledon to Dundonald Road

This is while we construct an additional platform and carry out enhancement work at Wimbledon station.

Trams will start and terminate at Dundonald Road which is around a 10 minute walk to Wimbledon station.

The walking route will be clearly signposted. Please allow extra time to complete your journey. You may find it easier to use an alternative route.

Local buses connect Wimbledon with London Trams at the following stops:

Merton Park – Wimbledon: 163 and 164

Morden Road – Wimbledon: 93

Phipps Bridge – Wimbledon: 200

Valid tram tickets will be accepted on these buses.

### Line closure Reeves Corner to East Croydon

This is to enable London Borough of Croydon Connect Improvement Scheme.

Trams from Beckenham Junction, Elmers End and New Addington will terminate at East Croydon

- Trams from Dundonald Road will terminate at Reeves Corner
- Line 4 will not run

Bus 410 links East Croydon and Reeves Corner.

Allow extra time to complete your journey.

You must have a valid ticket before using replacement bus services.
