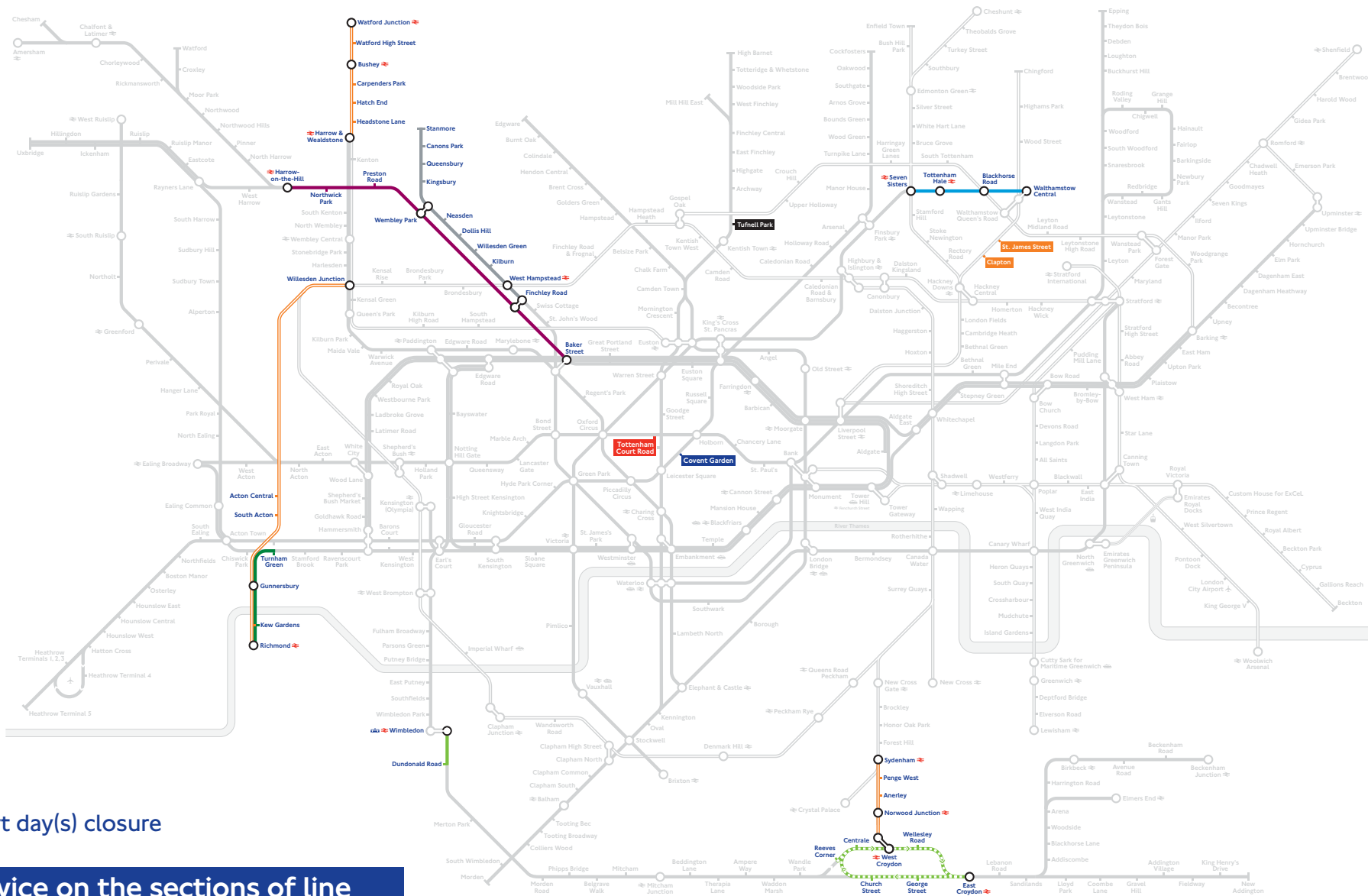


Network closures weekend of 22/23 August

Covent Garden station

Exit only until early November 2015. Also, on Saturdays and Sundays westbound trains will not stop.

This is while we replace two lifts.

St. James Street station

Exit only until 0930 Monday 17 until Friday 21 August.

This is while we renew the track layout at Walthamstow Central on the Victoria line.

Tottenham Court Road station

Central line trains not stopping until early December 2015.

This is while we carry out station improvement work.

Tufnell Park station

Station closed until mid-March 2016.

This is while we replace both lifts.

Line closure **Seven Sisters to Walthamstow Central**

Reduced services will run between Seven Sisters and Brixton.

This is while we renew the track layout at Walthamstow Central, which will allow us to run a more frequent service from next year.

 **Bus replacement for local journeys:**

Service A: Walthamstow Central – Blackhorse Road – Tottenham Hale – Seven Sisters

Service B: Walthamstow Central – St. James Street – Stratford International – Stratford City

In addition, TfL will operate an additional local bus route during this period on Mondays to Fridays:

Route 558: Chingford Mount – South Chingford – Walthamstow Crooked Billet – Highams Hill – Blackhorse Road – Tottenham Hale – Seven Sisters

 **Bus replacement for local journeys:**

Watford Junction – Watford High Street – Bushey – Carpenders Park – Hatch End – Headstone Lane – Harrow & Wealdstone

Use Bakerloo line between Harrow & Wealdstone and Queen's Park.

Line closure Wimbledon to Dundonald Road

This is while we construct an additional platform and carry out enhancement work at Wimbledon station.

Trams will start and terminate at Dundonald Road which is around a 10 minute walk to Wimbledon station.

The walking route will be clearly signposted. Please allow extra time to complete your journey. You may find it easier to use an alternative route.

Local buses connect Wimbledon with London Trams at the following stops:

Merton Park – Wimbledon: 163 and 164

Morden Road – Wimbledon: 93

Phipps Bridge – Wimbledon: 200

Valid tram tickets will be accepted on these buses.

Line closure Reeves Corner to East Croydon Open until 2200

Line closure Reeves Corner to East Croydon Open from 1000

This is due to London Borough of Croydon Connect Improvement Scheme.

Trams from Beckenham Junction, Elmers End and New Addington will terminate at East Croydon.

- Trams from Dundonald Road will terminate at Reeves Corner
- Line 4 will not run

Bus 410 links East Croydon and Reeves Corner.

Allow extra time to complete your journey.

You must have a valid ticket before using replacement bus services.
