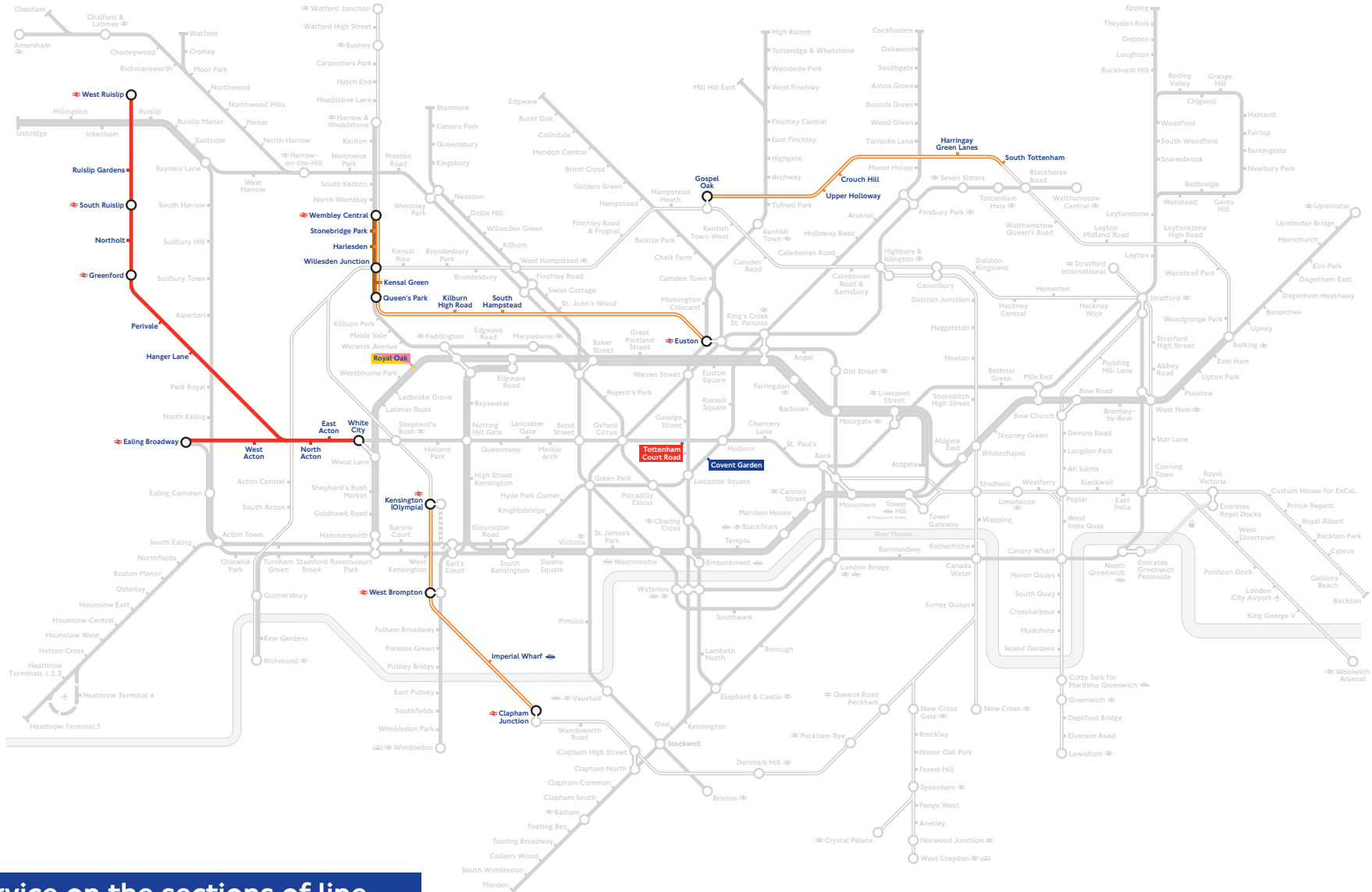


Network closures weekend of 25/26 April



No service on the sections of line shown in colour

Covent Garden station

Exit only until early November 2015. Also, on Saturdays and Sundays westbound trains will not stop. This is while we replace two lifts.

Tottenham Court Road station

Central line trains not stopping until early December 2015. This is while we carry out station improvement work.

Royal Oak station

Closed until mid-May.

This is due to Network Rail engineering work.

Line closure White City to West Ruislip/Ealing Broadway

This is to enable track replacement work at East Acton and Ealing Broadway, as well as drainage renewal work at White City.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Service A: White City (for the Hammersmith & City line from nearby Wood Lane) – East Acton – North Acton – West Acton – Ealing Common (for the District and Piccadilly lines) – Ealing Broadway (for the District line)

Service B: White City (for the Hammersmith & City line from nearby Wood Lane) – North Acton – Northolt – South Ruislip (for National Rail services) – Ruislip Gardens – West Ruislip (for National Rail services)

Service C: White City (for the Hammersmith & City line from nearby Wood Lane) – North Acton – Park Royal (for Piccadilly line) – Hanger Lane – Perivale – Greenford – Northolt

Line closure Kilburn High Road to Euston

This is due to Network Rail station work at South Hampstead.

Use local buses or London Underground via all reasonable routes – these tickets will only be accepted for entrance/exit at Queen's Park, Kilburn Park, Euston Square and Euston stations.

Line closure Wembley Central to Euston

This is due to Network Rail track work and station work at South Hampstead.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Wembley Central – Stonebridge Park – Harlesden – Willesden Junction – Kensal Green – Queen's Park

Between Queen's Park and Euston please use local buses or London Underground via all reasonable routes – these tickets will only be accepted for entrance/exit at Queen's Park, Kilburn Park, Euston Square and Euston stations.

Line closure Clapham Junction to Kensington (Olympia)

This is to enable Earls Court development work.

Use local buses via all reasonable routes.

Line closure Gospel Oak to South Tottenham

This is due to Network Rail infrastructure work.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Gospel Oak (bus stops at station) – Upper Holloway – Crouch Hill – Harringay Green Lanes – South Tottenham – Seven Sisters Tube

Allow extra time to complete your journey.

You must have a valid ticket before using replacement bus services.
