
Transport for London

Network closures weekend of 28 – 30 May



Holland Park station

Closed until early August.

This is while we replace both lifts.

Paddington station

Bakerloo line trains will not stop until mid-August.

This is while we renew both escalators and carry out work to prepare for the Elizabeth line.

District line

Saturday 28 to Monday 30 May

Line closure Earl's Court to Wimbledon

This is to allow for track replacement work at Fulham Broadway, Putney Bridge and Wimbledon.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Service A: Hammersmith – Putney Bridge – East Putney – Southfields – Wimbledon Park – Wimbledon.

Service B: Earl's Court – West Brompton (for London Overground and National Rail services) – Fulham Broadway – Parsons Green – Putney Bridge – Wimbledon.

London Overground

Sunday 29 to Monday 30 May

Line closure Gospel Oak to Barking

Network Rail carrying out major works to enable new, longer trains to run from 2018.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Service J: Gospel Oak (bus stops in Highgate Road) – Upper Holloway – Crouch Hill (bus stops in Hornsey Road) – Finsbury Park (Tube) – Harringay Green Lanes – Seven Sisters (for South Tottenham).

Service T: Walthamstow Central – Leyton Midland Road – Leytonstone High Road (bus stops at Harrow Green) – Wanstead Park – Woodgrange Park – East Ham (Tube) – Barking. Please note at East Ham eastbound buses stop to set down only; westbound buses stop

to pick up only.

Use local buses between South Tottenham and Walthamstow Queen's Road.

Use London Underground services between Finsbury Park and Walthamstow Central and also between East Ham and Barking.

Sunday 29 to Monday 30 May

Line closure Romford to Upminster

This is due to Network Rail infrastructure and Crossrail construction.

Use local buses via all reasonable routes.

London Overground

Monday 26

May

Line closure Hackney Downs to Chingford

Open until 2230 each evening

Network Rail track work.

Use London Underground via all reasonable routes - entrance/exit at; Liverpool Street, Seven Sisters, Tottenham Hale and Walthamstow Central stations.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Service L3: Hackney Downs – Clapton – St. James Street – Walthamstow Central Wood Street – Highams Park – Chingford.

Tfl Rail

Sunday 29 to Monday 30 May

Line closure Liverpool Street to Shenfield

Network Rail carrying out overhead power and track works, as part of its Railway Upgrade Plan and the Crossrail project.

Use London Underground via all reasonable routes – entrance/exit at; Liverpool Street, Seven Sisters, Tottenham Hale and Walthamstow Central stations.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Bus service D running from Shenfield to Newbury Park via Chadwell Heath. Calling at: Newbury Park (Central line) – Chadwell Heath – Romford – Gidea Park - Harold Wood - Brentwood - Shenfield.

Bus service C running from Romford to Stratford. (Not calling at Maryland). Calling at: Stratford – Forest Gate – Manor Park – Ilford – Seven Kings – Goodmayes Chadwell Heath – Romford.

Bus service A until 0830 Shenfield – Brentwood – Harold Wood – Gidea Park – Romford Chadwell Heath – Goodmayes – Seven Kings – Ilford.

Allow extra time to complete your journey.

You must have a valid ticket before using replacement bus services.
