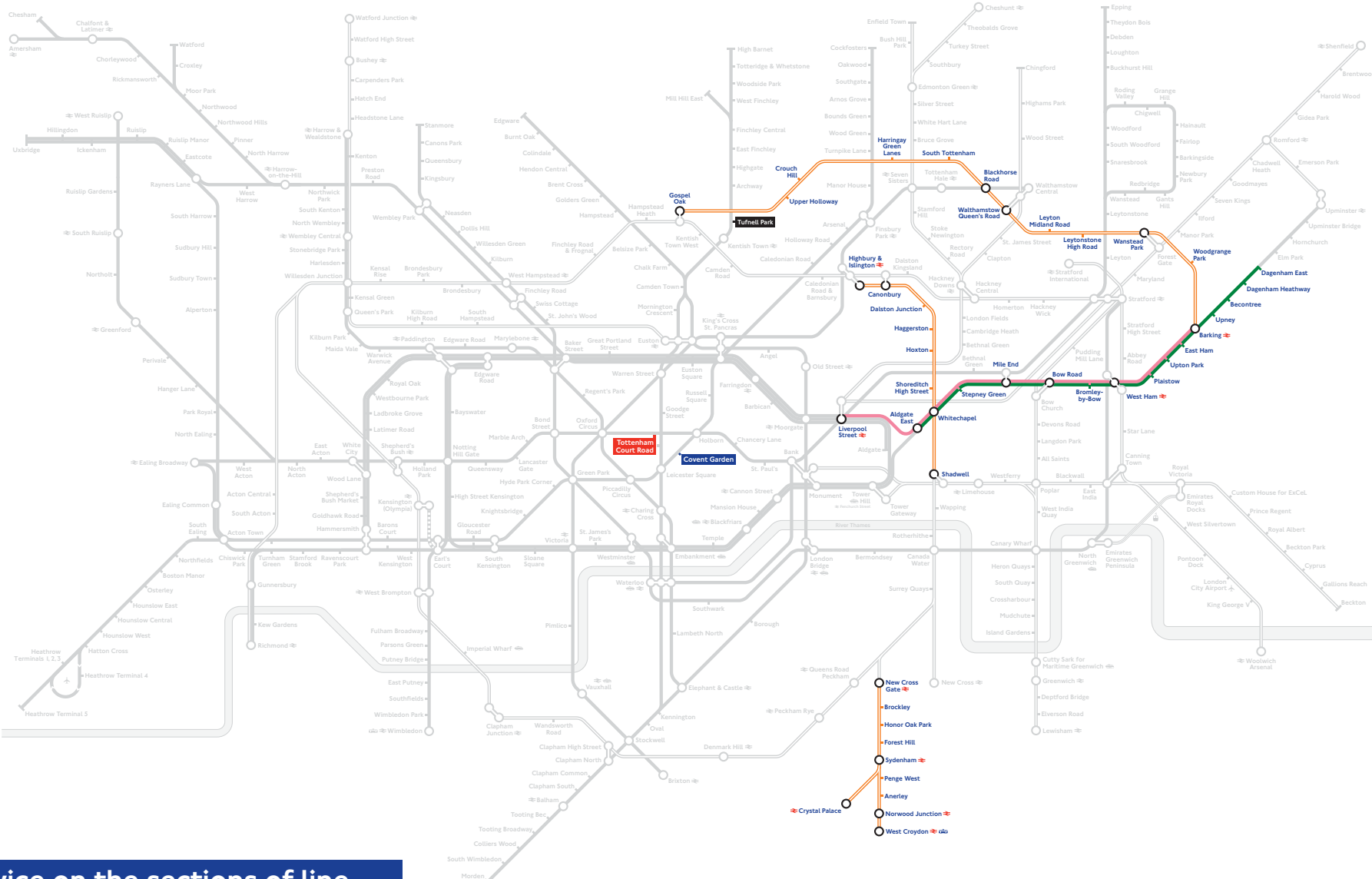


Network closures weekend of 4/5 July



No service on the sections of line shown in colour

Covent Garden station

Exit only until early November 2015. Also, on Saturdays and Sundays westbound trains will not stop. This is while we replace two lifts.

Tottenham Court Road station

Central line trains not stopping until early December 2015. This is while we carry out station improvement work.

Tufnell Park station

Station closed until mid-March 2016. This is while we replace both lifts.

Line closure Aldgate East to Dagenham East

This is to allow for Crossrail work at Whitechapel, track and drainage replacement work at East Ham, and station improvement work at Stepney Green.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Service A: Tower Hill – Aldgate/Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Stratford (for the Central and Jubilee lines and DLR, London Overground, TfL Rail and National Rail services) – Upton Park – East Ham – Barking (for National Rail services)

Service B: Mile End – Bow Road – Bromley-by-Bow – Canning Town (for the Jubilee line and DLR services) – Plaistow – Stratford (for the Central and Jubilee lines and DLR, London Overground, TfL Rail and National Rail services)

Service C: Barking (for National Rail services) – Upney – Becontree – Dagenham Heathway – Dagenham East

Service D: Barking (for National Rail services) – Dagenham East

Line closure Liverpool Street to Barking

This is to allow for Crossrail work at Whitechapel, replacing track and drainage at East Ham, and for station improvement work at Stepney Green station

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Service A: Tower Hill – Aldgate/Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Stratford (for the Central and Jubilee lines and DLR, London Overground, TfL Rail and National Rail services) – Upton Park – East Ham – Barking (for National Rail services)

Service B: Mile End – Bow Road – Bromley-by-Bow – Canning Town (for the Jubilee line and DLR services) – Plaistow – Stratford (for the Central and Jubilee lines and DLR, London Overground, TfL Rail and National Rail services)

Line closure Sydenham to Crystal Palace

This is to allow for Crossrail work.

Use Southern services

Line closure New Cross Gate to Crystal Palace/West Croydon

This is to enable Network Rail track work.

 **Bus replacement for local journeys:**

London Bridge – New Cross Gate – Brockley – Honor Oak Park – Forest Hill – Sydenham – Crystal Palace – Anerley (also for Penge West) – Norwood Junction – Selhurst – West Croydon

Line closure Highbury & Islington to Shadwell

This is to enable Crossrail work at Whitechapel.

Use London Overground trains between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Kingsland or local buses via all reasonable routes

 **Bus replacement for local journeys:**

Service W: Dalston Kingsland – Dalston Junction – Haggerston – Hoxton – Shoreditch High Street – Whitechapel – Shadwell

Use London Underground services via all reasonable routes (for entrance/exit at Canada Water and Stratford stations only).

Line closure Gospel Oak to Barking

This is to allow for Network Rail infrastructure work.

 **Bus replacement for local journeys:**

Route 1: Gospel Oak (bus stops at station) – Upper Holloway – Crouch Hill – Harringay Green Lanes – South Tottenham – Seven Sisters (Tube)

Route 2: South Tottenham – Blackhorse Road – Walthamstow Queen's Road – Walthamstow Central (Tube) – Leyton Midland Road – Leytonstone High Road – Wanstead Park – Woodgrange Park – Barking

Allow extra time to complete your journey.

You must have a valid ticket before using replacement bus services.
