

Line closure No service on entire line

This is while we test new signalling and replace track at Mansion House.

Saturday 8 to Sunday 9 October

Line closure Embankment to Dagenham East

This is to allow us to test new signalling, replace track at Mansion House and Barking, as well as Crossrail construction work at Whitechapel.

■ Rail replacement buses will run as follows:

Service A: Tower Hill – Aldgate/Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Stratford (for other TfL and National Rail services) – Upton Park – East Ham – Barking

Service C: Barking – Upney – Becontree – Dagenham Heathway – Dagenham East

Line closure Liverpool Street to Barking

This is while we test new signalling and replace track at Barking, as well as Crossrail construction work at Whitechapel.

Rail replacement buses will run as follows:

Service A: Tower Hill – Aldgate/Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road – Stratford (for other TfL and National Rail services) – Upton Park – East Ham – Barking

DLR

8 to Sunday 9 October

Line closure West Ham to Woolwich Arsenal

This is due to track work.

Please use local buses via all reasonable routes.

TfL Rail Monday 3 to Friday 7 October

Line closure Brentwood to Shenfield

Open until 23:00 and from 00:50 daily

This is for Network Rail engineering work.

Abellio Greater Anglia trains will call additionally at Brentwood.

8 to Sunday 9 October

Line closure Stratford to Shenfield Open until II:15 on Saturday

This is while Network Rail carry out track and station improvements as part of their Railway Upgrade Plan, as well as Crossrail construction work.

■ Rail replacement buses will run as follows:

Stratford – Forest Gate – Manor Park – Ilford – Seven Kings – Goodmayes – Chadwell Heath – Romford

Newbury Park (for the Central line) – Chadwell Heath – Romford – Gidea Park – Harold Wood – Brentwood – Shenfield

London Overground

Until February 2017

Line closure Gospel Oak to Barking

This is due to Network Rail carrying out major works to enable new, longer trains to run from 2018.

Rail replacement buses will run as follows:

Service J: Gospel Oak (bus stops in Highgate Road) – Upper Holloway – Crouch Hill (bus stops in Hornsey Road) – Finsbury Park (Tube) – Harringay Green Lanes – Seven Sisters (for South Tottenham)

Service T: Walthamstow Central – Leyton Midland Road – Leytonstone High Road (bus stops at Harrow Green) – Wanstead Park – Woodgrange Park – East Ham (Tube) – Barking

Please note at East Ham eastbound buses stop to set down only; westbound buses stop to pick up only.

Use local buses between South Tottenham and Walthamstow Queen's Road.

Use London Underground services between Finsbury Park and Walthamstow Central and also between East Ham and Barking. (except this weekend due to the District and Hammersmith & City line closures)

8 to Sunday 9 October

Line closure Highbury & Islington to Shadwell

This is due to Crossrail construction work at Whitechapel.

Use London Overground trains between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Kingsland or local buses between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Junction via all reasonable routes.

Rail replacement buses will run as follows:

Service W: Dalston Kingsland – Dalston Junction – Haggerston – Hoxton – Shoreditch High Street – Whitechapel – Shadwell.

Use London Underground services via all reasonable routes (entrance/exit at Canada Water and Stratford stations only).

London Overground Line closure Romford to Upminster Open until II:15 on Saturday This is due to Network Rail track work. Use local buses via all reasonable routes. Line closure Surrey Quays to New Cross 8 This is due to Crossrail construction work at Whitechapel. Use local buses via all reasonable routes or use New Cross Gate for connecting trains via Surrey Quays. Line closure Kilburn High Road to Euston Open from 12:00 This is due to Network Rail track work. Use local buses or London Underground services via all reasonable routes (entrance/exit at Queen's Park, Kilburn Park, Euston Square and Euston stations only). Line closure Liverpool Street to Enfield Town/Cheshunt 9 (via Seven Sisters)/Chingford Open from 10:15 This is due to Network Rail track work. Use Abellio Greater Anglia services between Liverpool Street and Cheshunt (via Tottenham Hale) Use local buses between Liverpool Street and Seven Sisters via all reasonable routes Use London Underground via all reasonable routes – entrance/exit at Liverpool Street, Seven Sisters, Tottenham Hale and Walthamstow Central stations. Rail replacement buses will run as follows: Service LI: Seven Sisters - Bruce Grove - White Hart Lane - Silver Street - Edmonton Green Bush Hill Park – Enfield Town. Service L2: Seven Sisters - Bruce Grove - White Hart Lane - Silver Street - Edmonton Green – Bush Hill Park – Southbury – Turkey Street – Theobalds Grove – Cheshunt. Service L3: Hackney Downs - Clapton - St. James Street - Walthamstow Central -Wood Street – Highams Park – Chingford. Line closure New Cross Gate to Crystal Palace/West Croydon

Open until 22:45

This is due to Thameslink work. Use local buses via all reasonable routes.

Rail replacement buses will run as follows:

(bus starts at London Bridge) – New Cross Gate – Brockley – Honor Oak Park – Forest Hill – Sydenham – Crystal Palace – Anerley (also for Penge West) – Norwood Junction – Selhurst - West Croydon.

Allow extra time to complete your journey. You must have a valid ticket before using replacement bus services. All information is correct at time of email being issued.
