

Know London Walking challenge Terms and Conditions

- The Promoter of the 'Know London Walking' competition is Transport for London, 42-50 Victoria Street, London, SW1H 0TL.
- Entry is open to UK residents excluding employees of Transport for London, or any of their subsidiaries, advisers, agents and/or anyone connected with the organisation of this promotion.
- The Competition begins on 5 August 2017 at 00:00 and ends on 5 August 2017 at 11:59. Any entries submitted after this time will not be counted.
- Only one entry per person.
- In order to enter you must download the Sporteering smartphone app and scan the barcode on the Legible London sign outside Royal Festival Hall. This will begin a three hour window in which you can visit other Legible London locations in the area to collect points. To complete the challenge and be entered into the competition, you must scan the barcode at Royal Festival Hall a second time.
- Three winners will receive prizes. The winners will be the top three high scorers according to the app. If more than three people gain the same score, the winner will be the person who achieved this score in the fastest time.
- There are three prizes. Each prize consists of a pair of Band A tickets to see *The Wind in the Willows* and are valid Monday to Friday until 1 September 2017, strictly subject to availability. No cash alternative is available and travel is not included.
- The winners will be notified by email by Friday 11 August 2017. The names of the winners and runners up will be posted on social media.
- The winners will be required to supply a method of delivery where prizes will be sent within 14 days of receiving confirmation of their postal addresses.
