

Lambswool Scarf competition terms and conditions

Entry is only open to UK residents aged 18 or over excluding employees of Transport for London, or any of their subsidiary’s advisers, agents and/or anyone connected with the organisation of this promotion. [If you are using your work computer you may need to obtain your employer’s permission prior to entering.] [The winner[s] will need to be able to provide proof of identity and age [with picture].]

The Competition begins on Friday 7 February 2020 (“the Opening Date”) and ends on Wednesday 12 February 2020 at 10:00am (“the Closing Date”). Entries to the Competition must be submitted before the Closing Date.

To enter, you must submit a response to the Instagram post in the comments section, and it must be your original work.

To submit a type of entry you must reply to the Instagram post in the comments section on <https://instagram.com/transportforlondon>. Any entry which is incomplete or submitted through an alternative method will be rejected.

Transport for London is not responsible for late, lost or delayed entries or network, computer hardware or software failures of any kind that may delay or restrict entry into the competition.

The winner will receive two Lambswool scarves.

The winner will be the entrant who in the sole opinion of the judges submits the most interesting reply.
