

## **Santander Cycles 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary competition terms and conditions**

The Competition begins on Tuesday 07 January 2020 (“the Opening Date”) and ends on Thursday 31 December 2020 at 17:00 (“the Closing Date”). Entries to the Competition must be submitted before the Closing Date.

Transport for London is not responsible for late, lost or delayed entries or network, computer hardware or software failures of any kind that may delay or restrict entry into the competition.

The winner will be the entrant who in the sole opinion of the judges submits the most interesting reply.
