## Ticket hall design

- Long overdue
- Luggage ramps to platform
- Excellent
- Thurloe Square exit concerns

## Platform design

- Excellent idea
- D&C identity

## Canopy design

- Glass canopy too low
- Would be better higher
- Waved design
- Hides brick arches
- Will glass stay clean?
- Recreate original



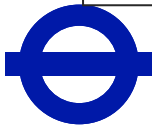
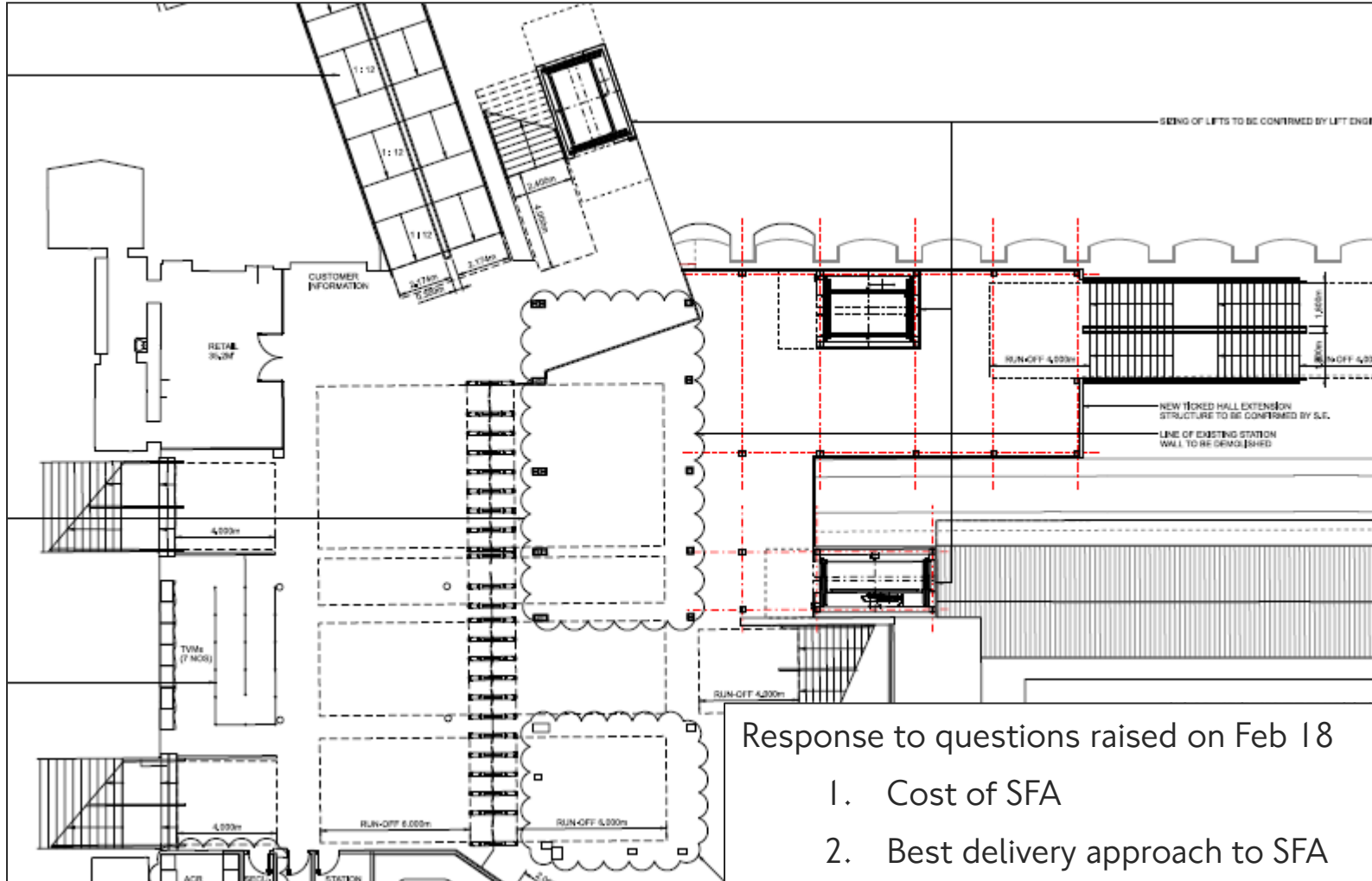
# Feedback from RBKC



- Reduce amount of glass and create some solidity in canopy
- Canopy needs to relate to design of the existing Edwardian canopy
- Balance between brick and glass needs to be considered

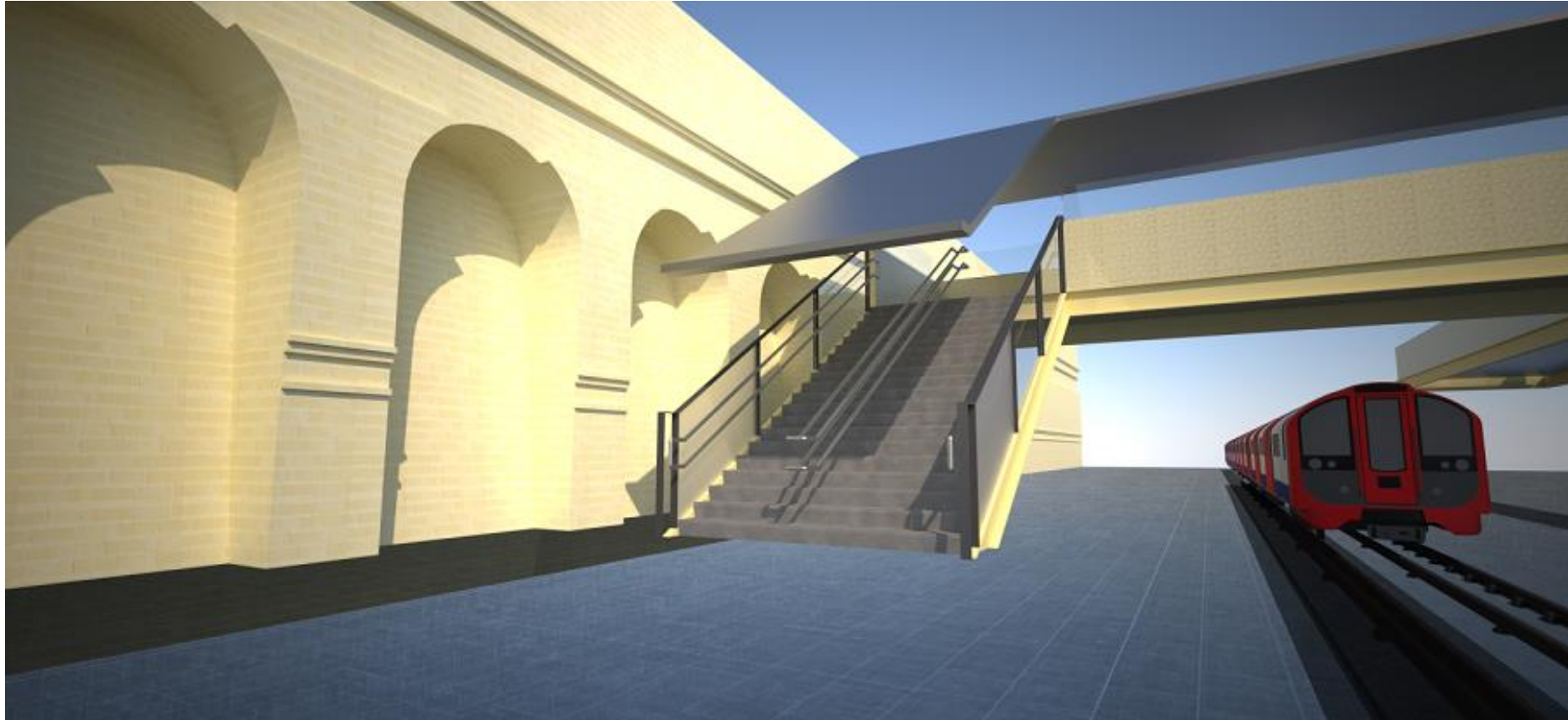

# Progress update: advertising



- The design proposes removal of 50% of existing advertising on new D&C platform
- Options to install smaller, appropriate advertising under review
- Importance to balance heritage character vs advertising revenue
- Design proposes 5 zones for adverts
- Only 2 adverts will be LCD advertising
- Visual advertising only with no sound
- Investigating opportunities to power down advertising at night
