## Buying your ticket

You need to buy the correct ticket to make a journey on the DLR and the Underground.

Look at the map, ticket price chart and answer the following questions.

**What is the price of a single ticket on a Zip Oyster on a Saturday?**

75p

**What is the price of a child (11-15) cash return ticket from Canning Town to Bank?**

£2.20 single (Zones 1-3)

£4.40 return (Double)

**Which Zones could you have travelled in if you paid £2.20 for a single cash ticket during a weekend day morning and you needed to go through Zone 1?**

**Circle the journey which would cost you more using your Zip Oyster?**

1. Monday morning return from Barking to Tower Hill. Zone 1-4. £0.80p single.

£1.60 total

2. Saturday return from Zone 1 to Poplar (£1.50 return) and a single from Poplar to Devons Road. (75p) £2.25 total, BUT off-peak price cap is £1.50

**How much would you need on your Zip Oyster Card to make a return from Liverpool Street to Bow Church after 8pm on a Tuesday?**

Liverpool Street to Bow Church = Two Zones 1-2 only. The journey is made after 7pm (off-peak) so it costs 75p for a single. £1.50 for a return.

**What is the daily off-peak price cap on your Zip Oyster?**

£1.50

**What is the peak price cap on your Zip Oyster if you travel in Zones 1-3?**

£5.30

Zip Oyster cards are quick, easy to use and you can top up your card at any

Underground station, touch screen ticket machine, ticket office or where you see the Oyster Top Up sign. You must always touch your Oyster card flat on the yellow readers at the start and end of your journey. The fare for your journey is then automatically deducted from the money on your card. A return fare is exactly double the price of a single.

You can use money on your Zip Oyster to travel on the Tube and DLR services. Double check if you can use on your local National Rail Services by asking a member of staff. Ticket prices will be different on National Rail services.

**Peak:** on Oyster, from 0630-09.30 am and from 16.00-19.00pm Monday to Friday

**Off Peak:** Off-peak single fares apply from 09:30-16:00 and after 19:00 Monday to Friday and all day at weekends and on bank holidays

**Price cap:** the maximum you will be charged during that day.
