# Permanent Bus Changes

## 20 April to 1 June 2018

This summary lists permanent bus changes that have been confirmed. The information is correct to the date shown below, but is subject to change for operational reasons.

We publish this summary every two weeks, normally on a Monday evening (Tuesday evening if the Monday is a Public Holiday). It includes confirmed permanent changes up to two weeks before and up to four weeks after the Friday prior to the publication date.

Permanent\* changes we list:

- New route
- Route withdrawn
- Route extended
- Route cut back
- Change to routing
- Change to frequency
- Significant additional journey added
- Significant additional journey withdrawn
- Change to timetable (routes / journeys designed for schools only)
- New fixed bus stops, replacing 'Hail and Ride' (if more than one stop)
- New buses (if all or most buses on a route)

\* including seasonal (e.g. summer only route extension / frequency increase)

We do not list:

- Change of operator
- Change to timetable (except routes / journeys designed for schools)
- Change to individual bus stop(s)

<b>N5</b>	<b>Trafalgar Square – Edgware</b>	<p>We’ve introduced an additional journey towards Edgware on Sunday nights, departing Trafalgar Square at 00:05, arriving at Edgware at 01:05.</p> <p>This fills a gap between the last Tube (Northern Line) train to Edgware, which departs Charing Cross at 23:42, and the previous first route N5 journey at 00:35.</p>	Barnet Brent Camden Harrow Westminster
<b>N20</b>	<b>Trafalgar Square – Barnet Church</b>	<p>We’ve introduced an additional journey towards Barnet Church on Sunday nights, departing Trafalgar Square at 23:55, arriving at Barnet Church at 00:46.</p> <p>This fills a gap between the last Tube (Northern Line) train to High Barnet, which departs Charing Cross at 23:42 (change at Camden Town), and the previous first route N20 journey at 00:25.</p>	Barnet Camden Haringey Islington Westminster
<b>N171</b>	<b>Tottenham Court Road – Hither Green Station</b>	<p>We’re progressively introducing new, more environmentally friendly diesel-electric hybrid double deck buses.</p>	Camden Lambeth Lewisham Southwark Westminster

<b>331</b>	<b>Ruislip – Uxbridge</b>	To improve reliability we've changed the timetable on Monday to Friday. Due to revised spacing of some journeys, there is be a slight reduction in frequency at certain times in peak hours, but the overall number of journeys remains the same, with one additional early morning journey towards Ruislip. <b>474</b>	<b>Manor Park – Canning Town, Barking Road</b>	<p>To improve reliability we've re-routed route 474 towards Manor Park via Factory Road and Store Road in North Woolwich. This will reduce delays caused by traffic in Pier Road queuing for the Woolwich Ferry.</p> <p>It continues to serve North Woolwich Ferry but no longer serves bus stop E 'Roebourne Way' in Albert Road – alternative bus stop F 'North Woolwich Police Station' is approx. 85 metres away and bus stop E continues to be served by route 473.</p> <p>There is no change to the route towards Canning Town as buses are not able to turn right from the North Woolwich Ferry bus stop.</p> <p>We're also progressively introducing new, more environmentally friendly diesel-electric hybrid double deck buses.</p>	Newham

<b>209</b> <small>(UPDATED)</small>	<b>Hammersmith – Mortlake</b>	<p>We're changing the timetable towards Mortlake on schoolday morning peak hours:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• one journey will be withdrawn</li> <li>• two journeys will be re-timed</li> </ul> <p>Between 07:40 and 08:20 buses towards Mortlake on schooldays will run every 10 minutes (previously every 5-10 minutes).</p> <p>This is to provide additional capacity and a better spread of journeys for students travelling to Harrodian School on route 609, which uses buses from route 209.</p>	Hammersmith and Fulham  Richmond upon Thames

<b>609</b> <small>(UPDATED)</small>	<b>Hammersmith – Barnes, Harrodian School / Mortlake</b>	<p>We're changing the timetable towards Mortlake in the morning:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• an additional journey will run</li> <li>• two of the existing three journeys will be re-timed</li> </ul> <p>There will be four morning journeys, each 10 minutes apart (previously three journeys, each 15 minutes apart).</p> <p>This is to provide additional capacity and a better spread of journeys for students travelling to Harrodian School.</p>	<p>Hammersmith and Fulham</p> <p>Richmond upon Thames</p>

<b>462</b>	<b>Ilford – Limes Farm Estate</b>	<p>To improve reliability we're changing the timetable. At Limes Farm Estate, buses will be scheduled to wait a little longer than previously at the 'Copperfield' bus stop, to allow more recovery time when delays occur.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• On Monday to Saturday until mid-evening most buses will wait for six minutes (previously four minutes)</li> <li>• On Sunday until mid-evening most buses will wait for six-seven minutes (previously four-five minutes)</li> <li>• Each late evening most buses will wait for three minutes (previously two minutes)</li> </ul> <p>Customers will still be allowed to remain on the bus to complete their journeys to / from the Limes Farm Estate loop but it may be quicker to walk to / from the 'Copperfield' bus stop.</p>	<p>Redbridge</p> <p>Epping Forest</p> <p>Essex</p>
