Permanent Bus Changes

21 September to 2 November 2018

This summary lists permanent bus changes that have been confirmed. The information is correct to the date shown below, but is subject to change for operational reasons.

We publish this summary every two weeks, normally on a Monday evening (Tuesday evening if the Monday is a Public Holiday). It includes confirmed permanent changes up to two weeks before and up to four weeks after the Friday prior to the publication date.

Permanent* changes we list:

- New route
- Route withdrawn
- Route extended
- Route cut back
- Change to routing
- Change to frequency
- Change to service coverage (e.g. evening / night service withdrawn or added)
- Significant additional journey added
- Significant additional journey withdrawn

- New buses (if all or most buses on a route)
- Change of vehicle type (e.g. single deck buses replaced by double deck buses) (if all or most buses on a route)

* including seasonal changes (e.g. summer only route extension / frequency increase) and very long-term temporary changes (e.g. in operation for several years)

- Change of operator
- Change to timetable (except on routes / journeys designed for schools)
- Change to individual bus stop(s)
- New buses (if not all or most buses on a route)
- Change of vehicle type (e.g. single deck buses replaced by double deck buses) (if not all or most buses on a route)

274 (NEW ENTRY)	Lancaster Gate – Islington Angel	<p>We're progressively introducing new, more environmentally friendly diesel-electric hybrid double deck buses, replacing the single deck buses previously on this route. The new buses are double deck to provide the capacity needed on this route at certain times without the cost of additional new single deck buses just for those times.</p> <p>The introduction of the new double deck buses was delayed from the originally planned date of 23 June 2018 while trees were cut back in some locations.</p> <p>As the double-deck buses will meet the extra demand from ZSL London Zoo on weekend afternoons during the spring, summer and autumn, we will no longer change the frequency each year during these times.</p> <p>Until we could introduce the new double deck buses, we temporarily added additional buses when needed for capacity at weekends.</p>	Camden Islington Westminster

<p>241 (NEW ENTRY)</p>	<p>Canning Town, Barking Road – Stratford City</p>	<p>We're changing the route in Stratford town centre, in conjunction with the second stage of the removal of the gyratory.</p> <p>Buses towards Canning Town will turn right from Angel Lane into the western section of Great Eastern Road, serving a new bus stop opposite Stratford bus station, run along the western section of Broadway, and turn right into Tramway Avenue. They will no longer run along the eastern section of Great Eastern Road, The Grove and the eastern section of Broadway. They will also no longer run along the short section of West Ham Lane next to Stratford Old Town Hall as this road is now permanently closed.</p> <p>There is no change to the route towards Stratford City except a change to the bus stop at Stratford bus station which is already in place.</p> <p>Changes to the bus stops are advertised locally.</p> <p>We consulted on this change in summer 2017.</p>	<p>Newham</p>

They will no longer run along the southern section of The Grove and Broadway.</p> <p>Buses towards Oxford Circus which start from Stratford will start from Stratford bus station, turn right from Stratford bus station into Great Eastern Road, and turn right into High Street.
