15/07/12	Methods to Attain Additional Data Concerning Collisions Involving Pedicabs: Reports of Pedicabs displaying what appeared to be a TfL roundel to be investigated. TfL requested that the MPS undertake a survey of pedicabs on the streets over the weekend of the 13/14 October 2012 to indicate how many vehicles are displaying a TfL roundel. Only one offending vehicle was recorded by the West End and Chinatown Safer Neighbourhood Team. The MPS has disclosed the details of the rider to TfL who are looking to pursue a breach of copyright. The MPS have requested that the offending rider removes the Roundel and provides the address of the printer to enable TfL to advise them accordingly.
