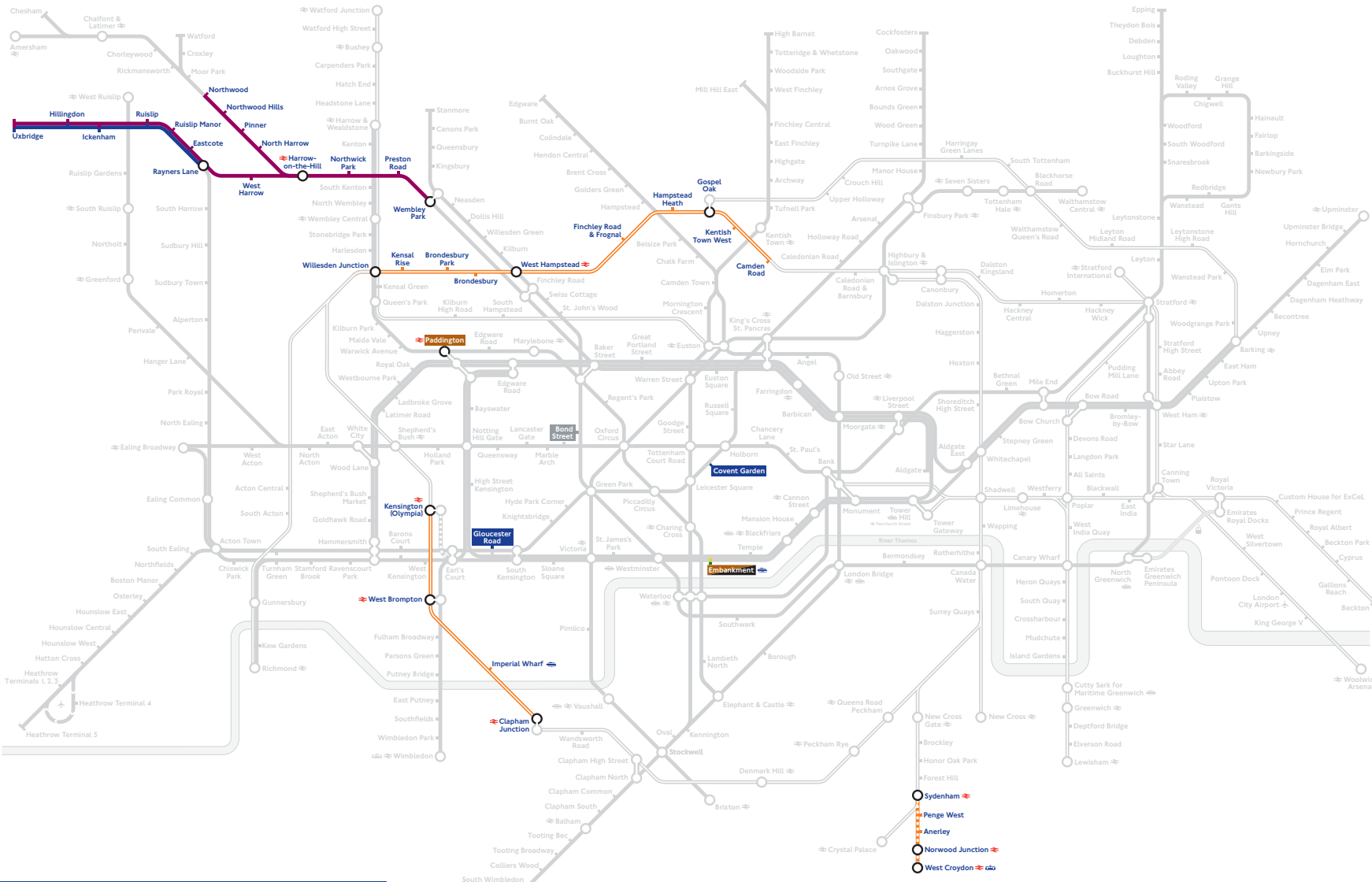


Transport for London

Network closures weekend of 19/20 July



No service on one or more days on the sections of line shown in colour

Bond Street station

Jubilee line trains not stopping until early December 2014.
This is while we carry out Bond Street station upgrade works.

Covent Garden station

Exit only until mid-November 2014. Also, on Saturdays and Sundays, westbound trains not stopping.
This is while we replace two lifts.

Embankment station

Bakerloo and Northern line trains not stopping until early November 2014.
This is while we replace four escalators.

Gloucester Road station

Piccadilly line trains not stopping until mid-December 2014.
This is while we replace both lifts.

Paddington station

Exit only from the Bakerloo line until late August 2014.
This is due to planned escalator improvement work.

Line closure Wembley Park to Northwood and Uxbridge

This is while we replace track at Hillingdon and replace points at Harrow-on-the-Hill.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Service A: Wembley Park – Kenton (for the Bakerloo line) – Harrow-on-the-Hill – West Harrow – North Harrow – Rayners Lane – Eastcote – Ruislip Manor – Ruislip – West Ruislip (for the Central line) – Ickenham – Hillingdon – Uxbridge

Service B: Wembley Park – Preston Road – Kenton (for the Bakerloo line) – Northwick Park – Harrow-on-the-Hill – West Harrow – North Harrow – Pinner – Northwood Hills – Northwood

Line closure Rayners Lane to Uxbridge

This is to enable us to replace track at Hillingdon.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Service A: Wembley Park – Kenton (for the Bakerloo line) – Harrow-on-the-Hill – West Harrow – North Harrow – Rayners Lane – Eastcote – Ruislip Manor – Ruislip – West Ruislip (for the Central line) – Ickenham – Hillingdon – Uxbridge

Line closure Clapham Junction to Kensington (Olympia)

This is to enable Network Rail work.

Valid rail tickets will be accepted on local buses via all reasonable routes.

Line closure Camden Road to Willesden Junction via West Hampstead

This due to platform extensions and associated signalling works to prepare the network for 5-car trains.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Camden Road – Kentish Town West (bus stops in Kentish Town Road) – Gospel Oak (bus stops at station) – Hampstead Heath – Finchley Road (for Finchley Road & Frognal) – West Hampstead – Brondesbury – Brondesbury Park – Kensal Rise – Willesden Junction

Trains will run to an amended timetable along an alternative route from Willesden Junction (low level platforms), calling at Kensal Green, Queen's Park, Kilburn High Road, South Hampstead, then Camden Road and all stations to Stratford.

Line closure Sydenham to West Croydon **Open from 0915**

This is to enable Network Rail track work.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Sydenham – Crystal Palace – Anerley (also for Penge West) – Norwood Junction – Selhurst – West Croydon

Allow extra time to complete your journey.

You must have a valid ticket before using replacement bus services.
