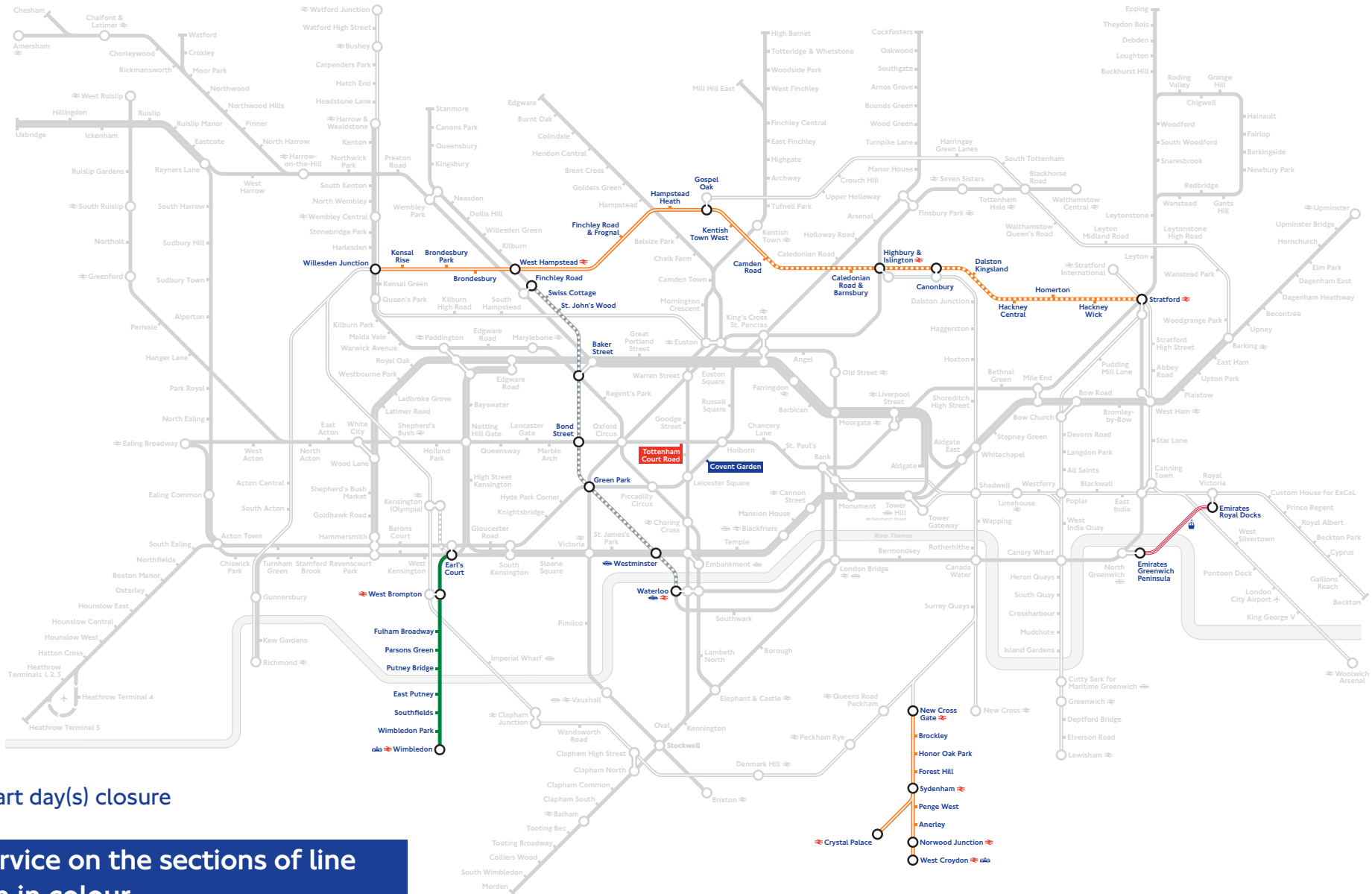


## Network closures weekend of 21/22 March



## Covent Garden station

Exit only until early November 2015. Also, on Saturdays and Sundays westbound trains will not stop. This is while we replace two lifts.

## Tottenham Court Road station

Central line trains not stopping until early December 2015. This is while we carry out station improvement work.

#### Line closure Earl's Court to Wimbledon

This is to allow for track replacement work at Putney Bridge and drainage improvement work at Wimbledon Park.

#### Bus replacement for local journeys:

**Service A:** Hammersmith – Putney Bridge – East Putney – Southfields – Wimbledon Park – Wimbledon (for National Rail and Tramlink services)

**Service B:** Earl's Court – West Brompton (for London Overground and National Rail services) – Fulham Broadway – Parsons Green – Putney Bridge – Wimbledon (for National Rail and Tramlink services)

#### Closed

The Emirates Air line is to be closed for important and planned maintenance work.

#### Alternative travel

The nearest alternative public transport is North Greenwich Tube station on the south side of the Emirates Air line served by the Jubilee line and Royal Victoria DLR station on the north side. Both are a short walk away from the Emirates Air line.

Bus services are available from North Greenwich bus station and Royal Victoria.

River services also operate from North Greenwich Pier next to the Emirates Greenwich Peninsula terminal.

### Line closure New Cross Gate to Crystal Palace/West Croydon

This is to enable the Network Rail track work and TfL station work at Crystal Palace.

#### Bus replacement for local journeys:

(bus starts at London Bridge) – New Cross Gate – Brockley – Honor Oak Park – Forest Hill – Sydenham – Crystal Palace – Anerley (also for Penge West) – Norwood Junction – Selhurst – West Croydon

### Line closure Camden Road to Stratford Open from 1315

This is while we prepare the network for five car trains and Network Rail infrastructure work.

#### Bus replacement for local journeys:

**Service S:** Camden Road – Holloway Road (Tube) (for Caledonian Road & Barnsbury) – Highbury & Islington – Canonbury – Dalston Junction (for Dalston Kingsland) – Hackney Central – Homerton – Hackney Wick – Stratford

**Service Q:** Camden Road – Highbury & Islington – Dalston Junction (for Dalston Kingsland) – Stratford

### Line closure Willesden Junction to Camden Road via West Hampstead

This is while we prepare the network for five car trains.

#### Bus replacement for local journeys:

Willesden Junction – Kensal Rise – Brondesbury Park – Brondesbury – West Hampstead – Finchley Road (Tube) (for Finchley Road & Frognal) – Hampstead Heath – Gospel Oak (bus stops in Agincourt Road/Southampton Road) – Kentish Town West – Camden Road

From 1315 trains will run to an amended timetable along an alternative route from Willesden Junction (low level platforms), calling at Kensal Green, Queen's Park, Kilburn High Road, South Hampstead, then Camden Road and all stations to Stratford.

Allow extra time to complete your journey.

You must have a valid ticket before using replacement bus services.
