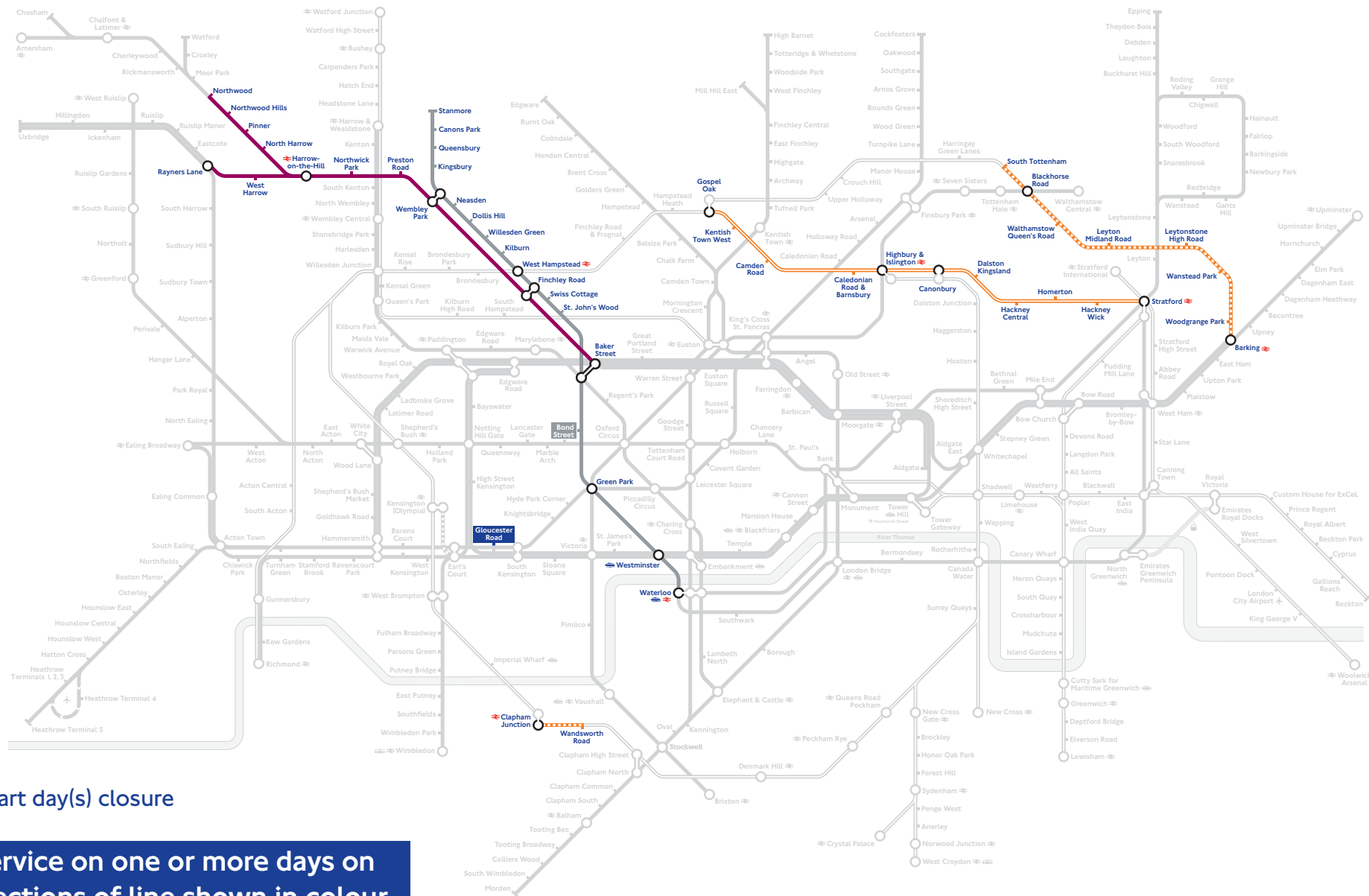


## Network closures weekend of 22/23 November



## Bond Street station



Jubilee line trains will resume stopping at the station from Monday 24 November when the station will become exit and interchange only until mid-December 2014.

### Line closure Clapham Junction to Wandsworth Road northbound

Open from 0815

This is due to Network Rail track work.

The 0720 and 0750 trains from Clapham Junction to Highbury & Islington will run along an alternative route, starting from Battersea Park (at 0722 and 0752) calling next at Wandsworth Road and then all stations to Highbury & Islington; southbound services are unaffected.

Use local buses via all reasonable routes between Clapham Junction and Battersea Park/ Surrey Quays or Southern services between Battersea Park and Clapham Junction.

### Line closure South Tottenham to Barking Open from 1200

This is due to Network Rail bridge work.

 **Bus replacement for local journeys:**

South Tottenham – Blackhorse Road – Walthamstow Queen's Road –  
Walthamstow Central (Underground) – Leyton Midland Road – Leytonstone High Road –  
Wanstead Park – Woodgrange Park – Barking

### Line closure Stratford to Gospel Oak

This is while we prepare the network for 5-car trains.

Kentish Town West – Camden Road – Holloway Road (Underground) (for Caledonian Road and  
Barnsbury) – Highbury & Islington – Canonbury – Dalston Junction (for Dalston Kingsland) –  
Hackney Central – Homerton – Hackney Wick – Stratford

**Service Q:** Camden Road – Highbury & Islington – Dalston Junction (for Dalston Kingsland) –  
Stratford
