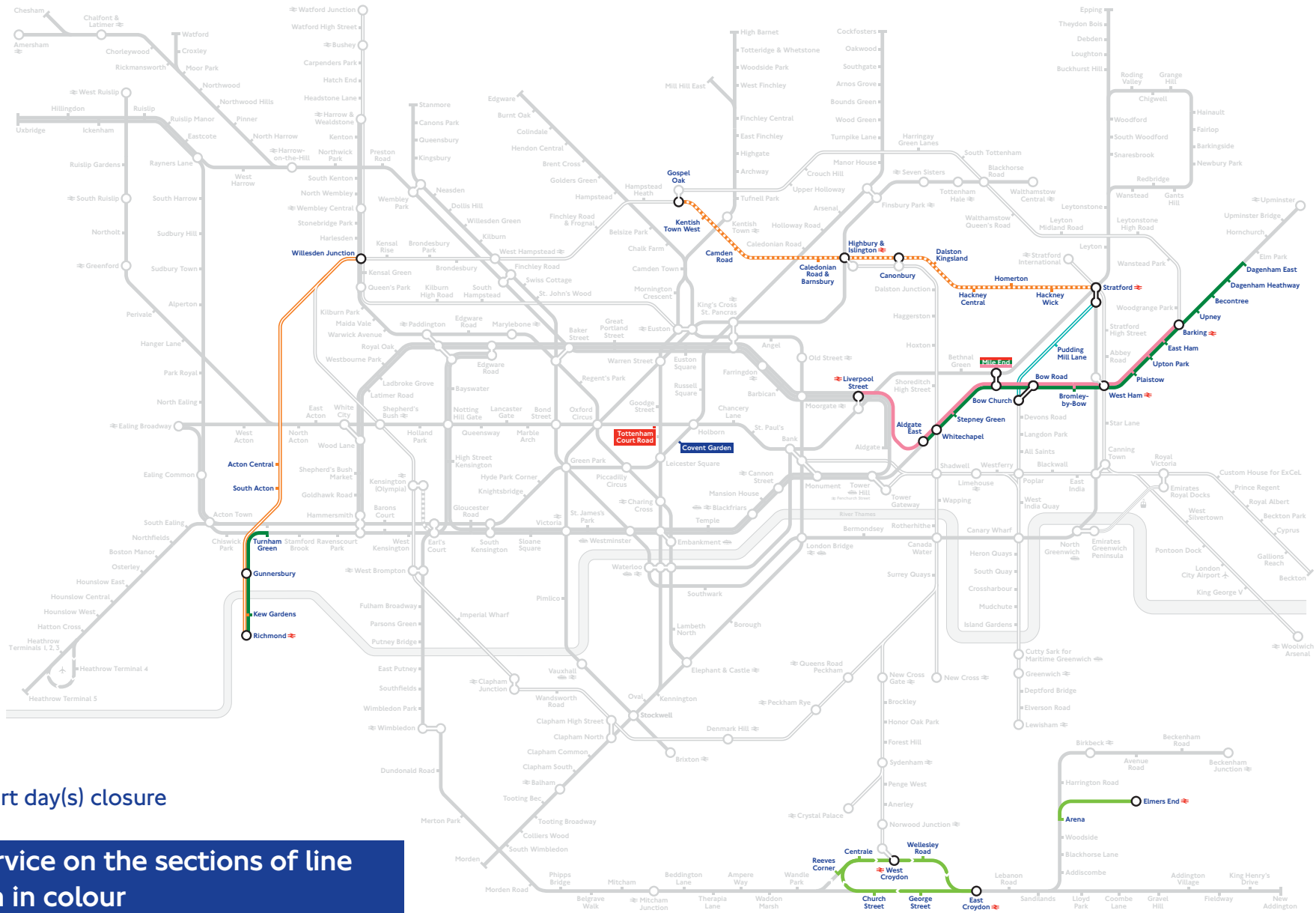


Network closures from Monday 18 May until Monday 25 May

Part day(s) closure

No service on the sections of line shown in colour

Covent Garden station

Exit only until early November 2015. Also, on Saturdays and Sundays westbound trains will not stop. This is while we replace two lifts.

Tottenham Court Road station

Central line trains not stopping until early December 2015. This is while we carry out station improvement work.

Mile End station

Closed Saturday 23 until Monday 25 May. This is due to track replacement work.

Line closure Aldgate East to Dagenham East

This is to allow for Crossrail work at Whitechapel and track and drainage replacement work at Mile End.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Service A: Tower Hill – Aldgate/Aldgate East – Whitechapel – Stepney Green – Mile End – Bow Road (for DLR services) – Stratford (for Central, Jubilee, DLR, London Overground and National Rail services) – Upton Park – Barking (for National Rail services)

Service B: Bethnal Green – Stepney Green (eastbound only) – Mile End – Bow Road (for DLR services) – Bromley-by-Bow – Canning Town (for the Jubilee line and DLR) – Plaistow – Stratford (for Central, Jubilee, DLR, London Overground and National Rail services)

Service C: Barking (for National Rail services) – Upney – Becontree – Dagenham Heathway – Dagenham East

Service D: Barking (for National Rail services) – Dagenham East

Line closure Turnham Green to Richmond

This is to prepare the Richmond branch for longer trains.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Service F: Richmond (for National Rail services) – Royal Botanical Gardens (Victoria Gate) – Gunnersbury – Chiswick Park – Turnham Green

Line closure Liverpool Street to Barking

This is while Crossrail work takes place at Whitechapel and we replace track and drainage at Mile End.

Line closure Willesden Junction to Richmond

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Willesden Junction – Acton Central – South Acton – Gunnersbury – Kew Garden(Victoria Gate) – Richmond

Line closure Stratford to Gospel Oak **Open until 2200**

This is to allow Network Rail track work.

Bus replacement for local journeys:

Stratford – Hackney Wick – Homerton – Hackney Central – Dalston Junction (for Dalston Kingsland) – Canonbury – Highbury & Islington – Holloway Road (for Caledonian Road & Barnsbury) – Camden Road – Kentish Town West – Gospel Oak (bus stops in Agincourt Road/Southampton Road) – Hampstead Heath

A connecting westbound only bus service at 2335 and 0010 will also run, only if required at Hampstead Heath and setting down only, as follows:

Hampstead Heath – Finchley Road Tube (for Finchley Road & Frognal) – West Hampstead – Brondesbury – Brondesbury Park – Kensal Rise – Willesden Junction – Acton Central – South Acton – Gunnersbury – Kew Gardens (Victoria Gate) – Richmond

Line closure Reeves Corner to East Croydon

This is to allow for essential track renewal works in Wellesley Road.

Alternative travel arrangements:

- Trams from Beckenham Junction, Elmers End and New Addington will terminate at East Croydon.
- Trams from Wimbledon will terminate at Reeves Corner.
- Line 4 will not run.
