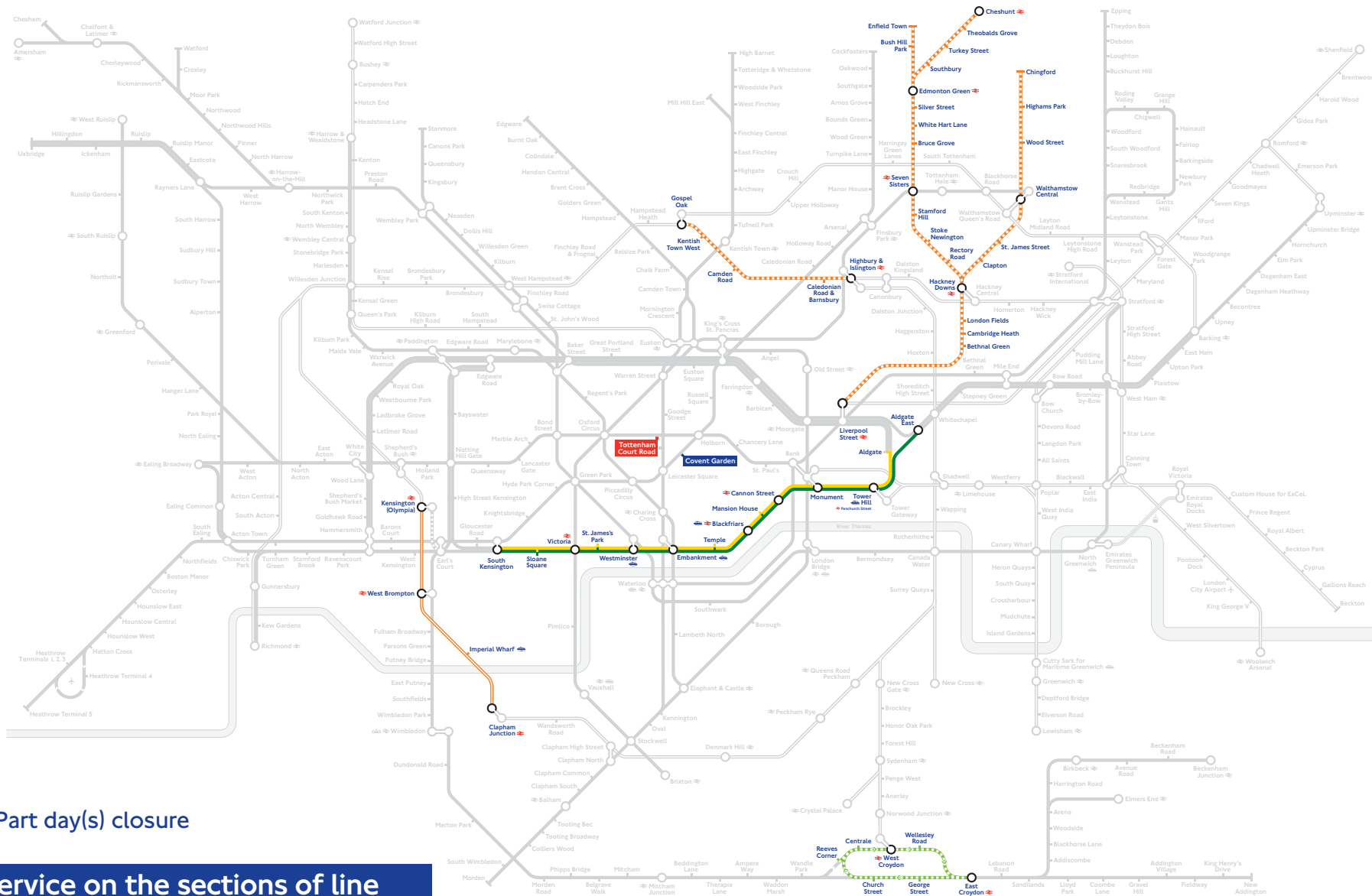


## Network closures weekend of 6/7 June



## Covent Garden station

Exit only until early November 2015. Also, on Saturdays and Sundays westbound trains will not stop. This is while we replace two lifts.

#### Line closure Clapham Junction to Kensington (Olympia)

This is to enable Earls Court Development  
Use local buses via all reasonable routes .

#### Line closure Gospel Oak to Highbury & Islington **Open from 1230**

This is to allow Network Rail track work.

##### Bus replacement for local journeys:

Hampstead Heath – Gospel Oak (bus stops in Agincourt Road/Southampton Road) –  
Kentish Town West – Camden Road – Holloway Road (for Caledonian Road & Barnsbury) –  
Highbury & Islington

#### Line closure Liverpool Street to Enfield Town/Cheshunt (via Seven Sisters)/ Chingford **Open from 1015**

This is to allow Network Rail track work.

Use Abellio Greater Anglia services between Liverpool Street and Cheshunt  
(via Tottenham Hale).

Use London Underground via all reasonable routes – these tickets will only be accepted for  
entrance and exit at Liverpool Street, Seven Sisters and Walthamstow Central stations.

Use local buses between Liverpool Street and Seven Sisters via all reasonable routes.

Use local buses between Hackney Downs and Walthamstow Central via all reasonable routes.

##### Bus replacement for local journeys:

**Service L1:** Seven Sisters – Bruce Grove – White Hart Lane – Silver Street – Edmonton Green –  
Bush Hill Park – Enfield Town

**Service L2:** Seven Sisters – Bruce Grove – White Hart Lane – Silver Street – Edmonton Green –  
Southbury – Turkey Street – Theobalds Grove – Cheshunt

**Service L3:** Walthamstow Central – Wood Street – Highams Park – Chingford

## London Trams

### Line closure Reeves Corner to East Croydon Open until 1400

This is due to a cycle race taking place in Croydon town centre.

#### Alternative travel arrangements:

There will be no through service across Croydon town centre.

- Trams from Beckenham Junction, Elmers End and New Addington will terminate at East Croydon
- Trams from Wimbledon will terminate at Reeves Corner
- Line 4 will not run

Bus 410 links East Croydon and Reeves Corner but due to road closures passengers may find it quicker to walk via Fell Road/Charles Street or West Croydon.

Allow extra time to complete your journey.

You must have a valid ticket before using replacement bus services.
