How to subscribe the National Electronic Sectional Appendix (NESAs)

To access NESAs you need:

- access to the internet
- a Network Rail Portal account with access to the NESAs website
- scalable vector graphics (SVG) viewer software, so you can view the route maps and track diagrams.

To set up a Portal account and access to NESAs, email nesa@networkrail.co.uk with the following information:

- the organisation that you represent
- your name and role within your organisation
- your work email address.

Please note: the NESAs mailbox is for access requests only. To raise any other issues regarding NESAs please email planningpublications@networkrail.co.uk.
