

Actions from the Surface Transport Panel Meeting of 9 April 2014 Night Bus Network Crime Figures

- 1.1 At its meeting on 9 April 2014, the Surface Transport Panel requested further information to be provided on crime figures for the night bus network. This information was requested on the back of bus related crime figures presented under Section 9 of the MD's report on Crime on the Bus Network. Year to date figures show a decrease in bus related crime figures and Members requested figures broken down to crime figures on the night bus network.
- 1.2 Following this request, the Enforcement and On Street Operations Directorate has provided the following information. The chart shows the bus related crime rates per million passenger journeys for the period midnight to 07:00 for the FY 2013/14 by month.



- 1.3 Reductions in night bus crime have been broadly consistent with the trends for overall bus related crime. The latest figures for 2013/14 show that there is one crime on the network for every 40,000 passenger journeys (relates to crimes between midnight and 7am).
- 1.4 Since 2007/08, the crime rate between midnight and 7am has reduced by 34.3 per cent. This should be read in the context of substantial growth in the ridership of the network.

1.5 TfL funded police resources regularly patrol night buses and we continue to focus specific operations on these issues. For example, last year "Operation Drag" delivered a number of high profile and successful operations on the N29 route involving covert police officers patrolling buses in the Camden Town area.
