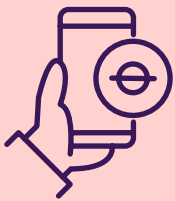

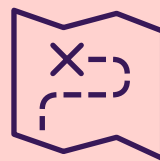
## Our TfL Go travel app

Our TfL Go travel app can help you access the network with information on step-free access by station and platform, accessible interchange information and toilet availability. The app can also tell you when stations are busy or quieter.

Plan your journey by station, address, postcode or from your current location, and apply step-free filters to access trains or platforms.

The app can be used with VoiceOver, Dynamic Type and preferred accessibility settings on iOS devices, and with TalkBack and accessibility settings for visibility enhancements on Android devices.

## Maps and guides

We have a wide selection of online and printed maps and guides available, including:

- Large print or black and white versions of the Tube map, as well as an audio guide
- Step-free Tube guide that shows the gap and step size between the train and platform, where boarding ramps are required and interchange options
- Avoiding stairs guide that shows the lifts, escalators and ramps between street and platform
- Tube toilets map that shows the locations of toilets and baby changing facilities
- Tube tunnels map that shows which parts of the network are largely underground
