

TfL 'superfans' competition

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Entrants must be aged 5-16, with one entry per child. Entries must be supervised by an adult
- Entries must be original work, must not be copied, must not have been published before in any other publication (or on any website), must not contain any third-party materials and/or content that you do not have permission to use, must not promote your own or third party goods or services or include any trade marks and must not promote inappropriate or dangerous behaviour, or otherwise be obscene, defamatory, distasteful, offensive or in breach of any applicable law or regulation. If TfL has reason to believe an entry is not original or otherwise breaches this paragraph, it may not consider it and may disqualify it.
- Transport for London is not responsible for late, lost or delayed entries or network, computer hardware or software failures of any kind that may delay or restrict entry into the competition.
- The judges' decision is final and binding in all matters and no correspondence will be entered into
- Twenty-five winners will be notified by the end of Wednesday 7 May
- Entrants who are relations of employees of TfL and its subsidiaries are permitted to enter. The relationship will have no influence on the competition outcome
- Entrants whose school does not currently take part in the TfL Travel for Life accreditation programme are permitted to enter
- Entrants do not need to seek permission from their school to enter
- Entries from those who live outside Greater London are welcome, but the entrant would need to be able to travel to the capital for their tour
- Winners will be offered a tour relating to their chosen transport mode, on a date to be arranged between TfL and the winner after the winners have been notified
- Winners and any other children attending a tour must be accompanied at all times by an adult
- All tours will take place outside standard school hours
- TfL is committed to making its network as fair, accessible and inclusive as possible, and will make reasonable adjustments for those with disabilities on the tours. In some circumstances winners may be offered an alternative tour if their accessibility needs cannot be met on a tour for their chosen mode
- TfL is not able to cover the costs for travel, accommodation, refreshments or any other expenses associated with the tour
- Winners will be invited to record a short message, from home, that will then be used as part of a PA announcement at a station. This can be recorded as a voice note and further instructions will be sent once winners are confirmed
- Entrants will not be required to reveal their full names in the PA announcements and can also opt out of having their full name used in any associated communications, such as social media posts and press releases.
- TfL staff may ask to take photos of winners and other tour attendees, for use in associated internal and public-facing communications. This is optional and winners/attendees can opt out at any time. Written consent from a parent/guardian will be required for the use of photos of the winner, along with their first name, age and location.
- Entrants will always be notified via email prior to any associated communications with names and photos being issued

- Entry into the Competition implies acceptance of these terms and conditions. Transport for London reserves the right to refuse to award prizes to anyone found to be in breach of these terms and conditions
- These terms and conditions are governed by English Law and shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts
