TPH driver survey

We're undertaking a [short survey](#) on the working practices of taxi and PHV drivers. The survey is open to any licensed taxi or PHV driver, whether you are currently working in the industry or not.

A41 Edgware Way

From 12 February until late spring 2022, we will be undertaking repair works on the A41 Edgware Way bridge over the M1, next to Apex Corner. This will include a number of full directional road closures and lane closures.

RMT Tube strike

RMT has announced strike action that could affect Night Tube services on the Central and Victoria line every Friday and Saturday night, between 20:30 and 04:29 the following morning, until Sunday 19 June. All other Tube lines will run their normal daytime services during these strikes.

Road updates

Planned road works

Bexley/Greenwich

- Until Saturday 5 February, there will be a series of overnight directional closures of the A2 between Dartford Heath, junction with the M25 and Blackwall, junction with the A207 whilst we carry out essential maintenance
- Work will take place between 22:00 and 05:00, Mondays to Fridays only, and will not affect access to the Blackwall Tunnel. You are advised to leave more time for your journey and follow the signed diversions

Westminster Bridge

- Until late January 2022, Westminster Bridge will be restricted to one lane in each direction for all traffic while we carry out essential works to improve the security of the bridge

Hammersmith Gyrotory

- Until 1 April 2022, works will take place on Hammersmith Gyrotory
- While these works take place, delays are likely and the surrounding areas are expected to be busy

A40 Westway

- Until summer 2022, there will be a series of overnight lane closures and weekend directional closures on the A40 Westway while we carry out essential maintenance work

Ongoing works on the Woolwich Ferry

- There is no service on the Woolwich Ferry
- Service is expected to resume in the New Year
- Use alternative river crossings at Dartford, Blackwall and Rotherhithe

Changes to the access road for Lewisham Market

- Access to the service roads for Lewisham Market are for permit holders only and strict enforcement via camera will soon commence resulting in the issue of PCNs
- LB Lewisham have exempted taxis from penalties within the Traffic Management Order
- However, taxi drivers that require access will need to email parkingclientteam@lewisham.gov.uk with their name, MHC licence number and vehicle details. Their VRM will be added to the database so that they are not issued with a PCN
- Once enforcement has commenced, if a taxi driver changes vehicle, they will need to email Penaltychargenotices@lewisham.gov.uk with their new vehicle details. At least 24 hours' notice is required to change vehicle details

- 6023 Brook Street, from 00:01 on Saturday 22 until 23:00 on Monday 24 January. Whole rank to be suspended for crane operation
- 6166 Old Street (All Bar One), from 07:00 on Saturday 22 until 00:01 on Monday 24 January. Whole rank to be suspended for carriageway utility works
- 5737 Cranbourn Street, from 07:00 on Monday 24 until 18:00 on Wednesday 26 January. Whole rank to be suspended for carriageway utility works
- 5541 Park Lane (Dorchester Hotel), from 07:00 on Monday 24 until 18:00 on Friday 28 January. Whole rank to be suspended for carriageway utility works
- 3998 Caxton Street, on Monday 24, Tuesday 25 and Thursday 27 January. Whole rank to be suspended between 07:00 to 18:00 on all three days for a crane operation
- 6151 New Bond Street (Oxford Street), from 07:00 on Monday 24 until 18:00 on Friday 28 January. Whole rank to be suspended to facilitate carriageway utility works
